

**ANN ARBOR CITY COUNCIL MINUTES
WORKING SESSION - APRIL 9, 2001**

The working session of the Ann Arbor City Council was called to order at 7:05 p.m. in the City Hall Council Chamber by Mayor John Hieftje.

SANITARY SEWER OVERFLOW TASK FORCE UPDATE

Sumedh Bahl, Water Treatment Plant Superintendent and Sanitary Sewer Overflow Task Force Member; Mark TemBroek, of Camp, Dresser, McKee, consultant for the Sanitary Sewer Overflow Study; Steven Rapandalo, Sanitary Sewer Overflow Task Force Co-Chair; and Susan McCormick, Water Utilities Director, gave a slide presentation on the Ann Arbor Sanitary Sewer Overflow Task Force recommendations. The Task Force's final recommendations included implementing a City-wide footing drain disconnection program, starting with the homes within the five study areas (Orchard Hills, Bromley, Dartmoor, Glen Leven and Morehead). Recommended funding sources for the program include Wastewater Utility reserves, Wastewater Utility revenue bonds issued by the City, and State Revolving Fund loans.

Jane Book, Bromley resident representative to the SSO Task Force, urged Council to take immediate action to implement the recommended program.

The presentation was followed by questions and comments from Council.
