JEAN CARLBERG, THIRD WARD COUNCIL MEMBER, TO BE FEATURED ON “CONVERSATIONS”

ANN ARBOR, Mich., Sept. 28, 2006 — Ann Arbor City Council Member Jean Carlberg’s term will come to a close in 2006, ending 12 years on the council. She will discuss her years of service, her decision not to run again, as well as what her future may hold on the Wednesday, Oct. 4, edition of “Conversations”, 10:30 a.m. on Community Television Network CitiTV Channel 19.

“Conversations” replays Monday – Friday at the following times: 10:30 a.m., 6:30 p.m. and 10:30 p.m., and Sundays at 6:30 p.m. The series, hosted by Jim Blow, features monthly dialogue with local decision makers.

CTN has been on the air since 1973 and operates cable channels 16, 17, 18 and 19 on the Comcast Cable System in the greater Ann Arbor area.

Ann Arbor has 114,000 residents, spans 27.7 square miles, and was named one of the top 25 U.S. cities to live in by CNN/Money Magazine in 2006. The city’s mission statement reads: The city of Ann Arbor is committed to providing excellent municipal services that enhance the quality of life for all through the intelligent use of resources while valuing an open environment that fosters, fair, sensitive and respectful treatment of all employees and the community we serve.
