Non-perishable food: canned items such as soup, meats (tuna fish, chicken) or vegetables; packaged items like pasta, rice, cereal, oatmeal, baking supplies, granola bars, Goldfish; condiments; nut butters or jelly; and baby food or formula; nutritious snacks (granola or oat bars, popcorn, trail mix, veggie chips/straws/crisps, individual apple sauce, fruit bars, crackers, jerky, fruit chips/crisps, quinoa/rice cakes, pretzels).

Toiletries: deodorant, toilet paper, shower gel, shaving gel, shampoo, soap, toothbrushes, toothpaste, hand wipes. Household items: laundry liquid detergent, laundry powder, washing up liquid. Feminine products: sanitary towels and tampons. Baby supplies: diapers, baby wipes and baby food.
