# Be a Student Election Inspector on November 5th!

The City of Ann Arbor Clerk's Office is recruiting hundreds of inspectors to work as poll workers on Election Day. Poll workers can be assigned to any of the City's 47 precincts, and typically work from 6:00 a.m. to approximately 10 p.m. (with two one-hour paid breaks!) to set up for the day, process voters, then pack up and close the polls. This opportunity is available to high school students who will be 16 on or before Election Day, are U.S. Citizens, and are in good academic standing. Election inspector pay begins at \$18.00/hour.

## HOW IT WORKS

- 1. Complete & return the student election inspector application and permission slip to the Ann Arbor City Clerk's Office**
- 2. We'll reach out with information about signing up for a required paid training. Training will take place at 3021 Miller Rd., Ann Arbor.**
- 3. Attend the paid training**
- 4. Work on Election Day**
- 5. Receive your pay approximately 2-4 weeks after the election**
