# **QUESTIONS ABOUT LICENSING**

#### WHY GET A DOG LICENSE?

Michigan law requires all dogs over the age of six months to be licensed. Plus, licensing protects the public by requiring rabies vaccinations. A dog license can also help reunite owners with their dog should they ever get lost.

#### WHICH LICENSE SHOULD I GET?

Dog licenses are sold in accordance with the provisions of the Dog Law of 1919 as amended. Public Act 339 as amended, MCL 287.261-290, the Dog Law of 1919, option (f) of section 6(c) states:

• That the owner apply for a license by one of the following at the owner's option:

\* The last day of the month of the dog's current rabies vaccination every year.
\* The last day of the month of the dog's current rabies vaccination every third year.

All dogs over six months of age must be vaccinated against rabies before a license can be issued. The vaccinations must remain current in order for owners to obtain annual dog licenses.

#### WHAT IS THE COST?

The following dog licensing fees were established effective Nov. 1, 2014 by Council Resolution 14-1412:

- \$6 for up to one year (\$12 for unaltered dogs)
- \$15 for up to three years (\$30 for unaltered dogs)

Service Dog - No charge with proper documentation.

# Did you know the City of Ann Arbor has a dog leash law?

Per Chapter 107, 9:47(1), the city code, it is a violation to have a dog off-leash in city parks, other than in a designated dog play area. The violation is punishable, per Chapter 107, 9:52 by a fine of not less than \$25 nor more than \$500 for a first offense and for a second offense not less than \$50 nor more than \$500.

# LICENSING AND FEES

**One year license qualifications:** You must submit a valid rabies certificate with the application. The license will expire on the last day of the month of the rabies vaccine.

**Three year license qualifications:** You must submit a rabies certificate valid for at least 24 months from the date of application. The license will expire on last day of the month of the rabies vaccine.
