Re: **NOTICE: Final Plan Revision for Traffic Calming on Granger Ave (Packard to State)**

Dear Granger Avenue Resident/Owner,

Thank you for your participation and involvement in the Granger Ave Traffic Calming Project. The final plan was approved in June 2023 and your patience with the installation of devices has been greatly appreciated.

The installation of these devices has taken time due to scheduling conflicts with our contractor and technical challenges recently experienced at other locations when installing raised crosswalks and raised intersections.

Due to the considerations, the final plan for traffic calming on Granger Ave from Packard to State has been slightly revised, reference revised plan included. The following three (3) devices have been modified:

Device 1 - Raised intersection at Granger Ave and White St will be installed within the intersection but will no longer include the crosswalks.

Device 2 - Raised Crosswalk at E. Park Pl will become a speed hump which will be located just west of the crosswalk.

Device 3 Raised Crosswalk at Golden Ave will become a speed hump which will be located just east of the crosswalk.

Why did the revision(s) occur?

It's the city's responsibility to make sure all crosswalks are compliant with Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). Due to the geometry of Granger Ave it is unachievable to install the raised intersection affecting the crosswalks and two (2) raised crosswalk in a manner that would reduce speed and be American with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant.

Who was part of this decision?

Transportation Engineers, the Transportation Manager, and experts in construction inspection have been working hard to try and determine a feasible plan to install the devices as originally approved. However, the decision to make these changes was made after a field visit was conducted and it was determined modifications were warranted to achieve speed management as well as ADA accessibility..

When will the revised plan be installed?

The revised plan will be installed as part of the Resurfacing Program prior to July 1, 2024. Notification will go out to all residents in the project area prior to construction.
