- Answer 1: Contractors not on the city's list of pre-qualified asbestos abatement contractors can request to become qualified by submitting a copy of their current asbestos abatement contractors license and for the past three years, any history of received or alleged violations as a result of inspections conducted by Michigan Occupational Safety & Health Administration (MIOSHA), U.S. Department of Labor Occupation Safety and Health Administration (OSHA), U.S. Environmental Protections Agency (EPA), Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy or other environmental, health and safety agencies. Include the above information in the proposal response.
