Media Release

On 5/6/24 at approximately 1:00am, officers responded to the 1500 block of Marlborough Drive for a report of shots fired. When officers arrived on scene, they located several shell casings throughout the street.

Preliminary investigation revealed a subject or subjects inside a vehicle fired multiple shots into a home on Marlborough Drive. There were five people inside the residence, including three juveniles. No one in the home was physically injured. During the investigation officers also discovered other homes in the area were struck by gunfire.

The shooting is not believed to be random. A motive for the shooting is currently under investigation and detectives are currently working to develop suspect information. This is an open and active investigation. Official statement from Chief of Police Andre Anderson:

"Gun violence at any level is unacceptable in our community. We are very fortunate that this incident didn't result in serious injuries. The department is actively putting resources together to address what happened."
