### DESCRIPTION

Beginning at an iron pipe monument on the east line of Church Street, 66 feet east of the northeast corner of Judson's First Addition to the City of Ann Arbor, the plat of which is recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds for the County of Washtenaw, Michigan, in Book 2 of Plats. on Page 23, thence N. 88° 41' E. along the north line of Judson's First Addition produced, 277.18 feet to an iron pipe monument, or the west line of Forest Avenue; thence S. 0° 36' W. along the west line of Forest Avenue, 266.72 feet to an iron pipe monument at the northeast corner of Miller's Addition; thence S. 88° 39' W. along the north line of Miller's Addition, 274.53 feet to an iron pipe monument on the east line of Church Street; thence North, 266.64 feet along the east line of Church Street to the place of beginning.

### SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I hereby certify that the plat hereon delineated is a correct one and that permanent monuments, consisting of iron pipe, 3/4" x 30", have been placed at all points marked thus O as thereon shown, at all angles in the boundaries of the land platted and of all intersections of streets.

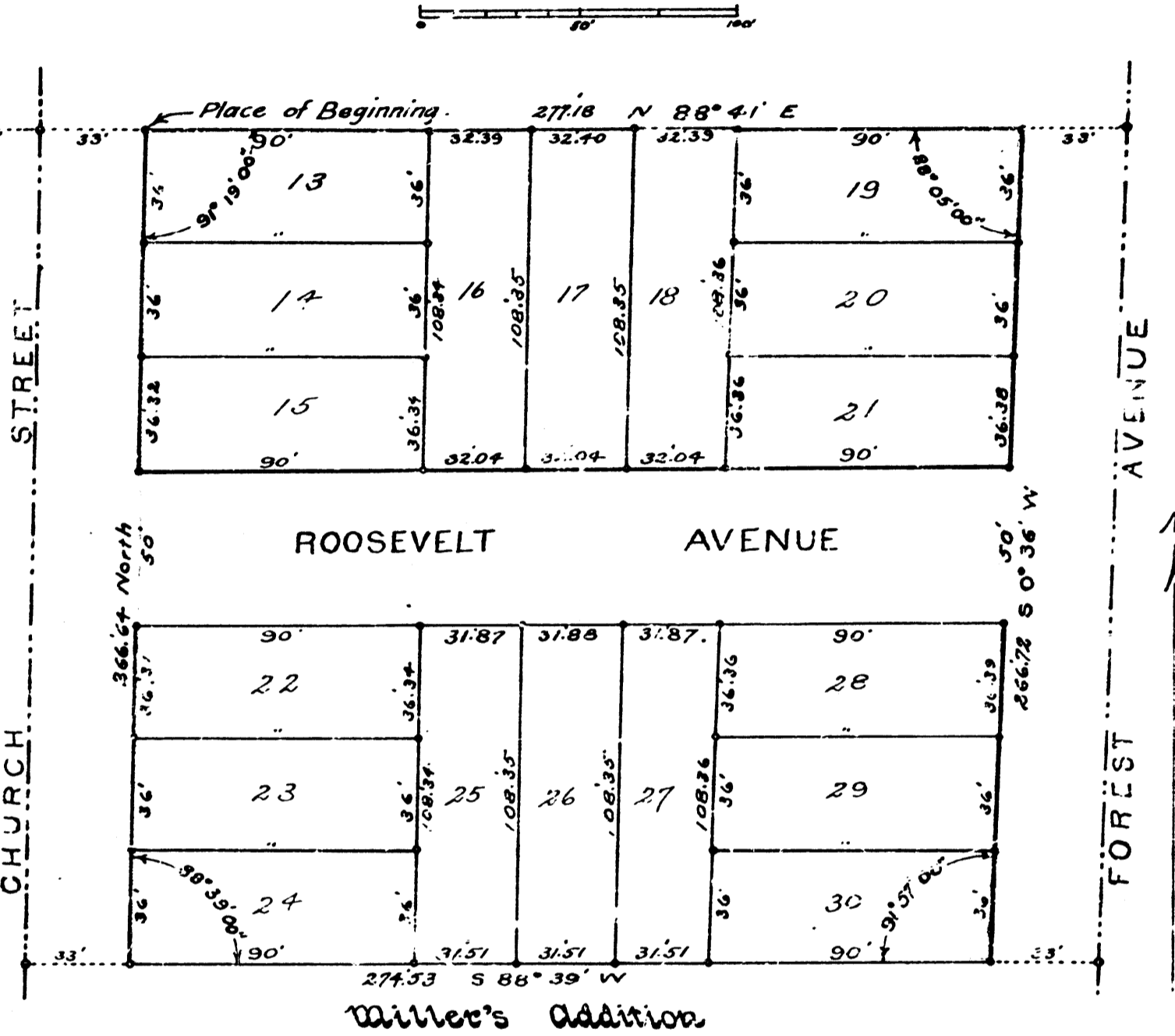
