

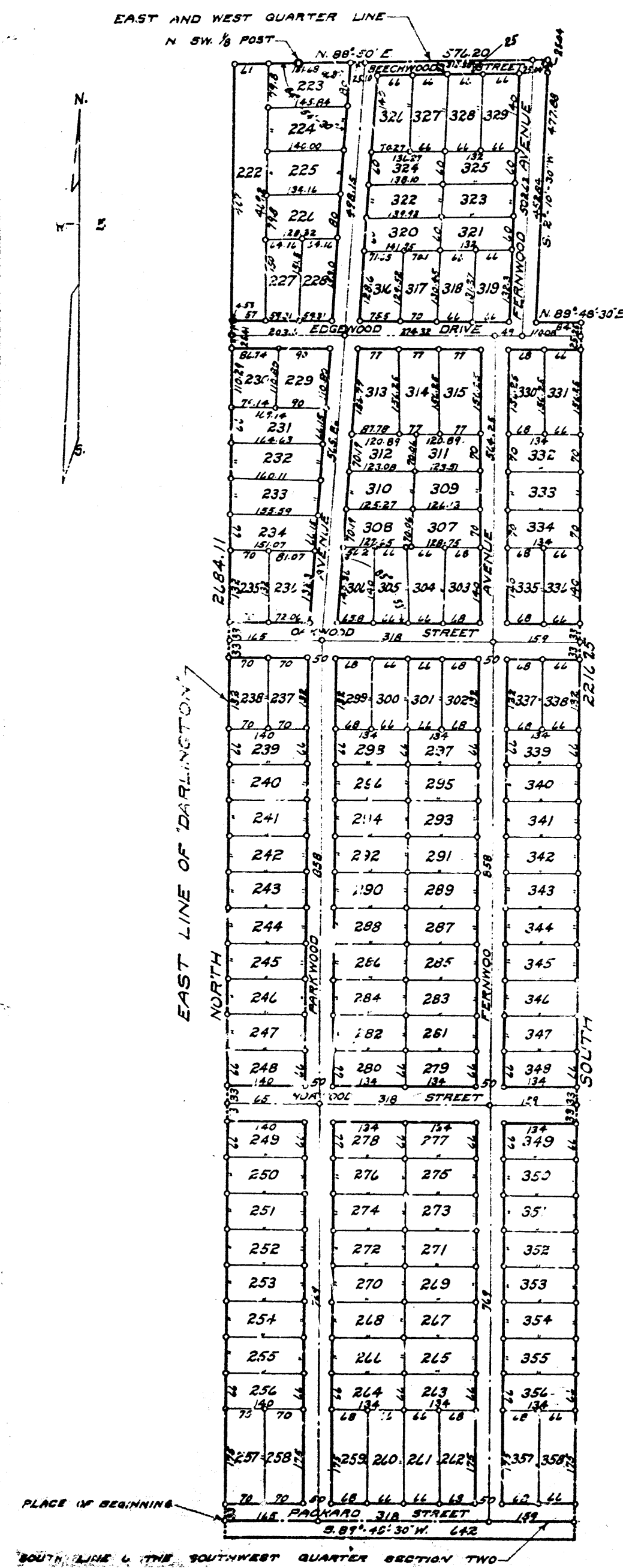

DESCRIPTION

The land embraced in the annexed plat of "DARLINGTON NUMBER ONE" a subdivision of part of the southwest quarter section two, Pittsfield Township, Washtenaw County, Michigan, is described as follows: Commencing at an iron pipe at the southeast corner of "DARLINGTON", a subdivision of part of the southwest quarter, section two, Pittsfield Township, Washtenaw County, Michigan, said pipe being in the south line of section two, Pittsfield Township, and north 89 degrees 48 minutes and 30 seconds east 1211 feet from the southwest corner of said section; thence north 2894.11 feet to an iron pipe; thence north 38 degrees and 50 minutes east 576.20 feet to an iron pipe; thence south 2 degrees 10 minutes and 30 seconds west 477.88 feet to an iron pipe; thence north 89 degrees 48 minutes and 30 seconds east 84 feet to an iron pipe; thence south 2216.25 feet to an iron pipe; thence south 59 degrees 48 minutes and 30 seconds west 542 feet to the place of beginning.
