


# Plan of Smith's Addition To Ann Arbor City

A copy of this plan was filed in Washtenaw County 88. Filed for Record this 13<sup>th</sup> day of August 1857  
at 12 o'clock M.M. & recorded in Liber No 42 of Grants on page 144, 6<sup>th</sup> Edmund  
T. R. Martin Register A. Gardner Deputy

This plan of Smith's Addition to the city of Ann Arbor is situated on the East half of the South West quarter of section 28 of Township 2 South of Range 11 East and immediately East of the University Square in the city of Ann Arbor. The Streets are 4 Rods wide. The Alleys one Rod wide. The length of lots are given in chains and links. Said by calling University Avenue and Church Street North and South. Orleans and College Streets East and west. Fletcher Street is South 42° Degrees East. The Lots are numbered from No 1 to 87 in red ink thus 12345  
Surveyed and Plotted by J. Petibone in August 1857. Two chains to the South. North corner one chain East and 49 links South of North east corner of University square. South west corner is one chain East and 51 links South of South east corner of University square. Plotted August 12<sup>th</sup> 1857 Ransom S. Smith

Lucy Ann Batchelder his wife of the Township of Upland in the County of Washtenaw  
and State of Michigan do make for and in consideration of the sum of Thirteen hundred and  
Twenty five Dollars to us in hand now due said the Receipt of which is  
hereby acknowledged have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do  
grant bargain sell release and convey unto William C. Fenn of the town of  
Upland County of Washtenaw State of Michigan trustee and his heirs and assigns for  
ever all and certain tract or parcel of Land situated in the Township of Upland in the  
County of Washtenaw State of Michigan known bounded and described as follows  
viz., a Village Lot Numbered One hundred addition to the village of Upland  
no Eight (8) . Together with all the appurtenances thereto and all the right title  
interest estate claim and demand of the grantor and each of them in and to the  
premises to forever thereon to have and to hold the same unto the said grantee his  
heirs and assigns in fee simple forever & that the said grantee shall have and hold  
Lucy Ann Batchelder for the uses and benefits of the said grantor and to her  
concerned and agrees with the said grantor and his heirs and assigns that they are seized of  
a good sure perfect right & title to the said premises in fee simple in the premises and  
every part thereof and that he have full right and power to sell and convey the same in fee simple  
absolute that the same are free and clear from any encumbrance whatever the said  
Grantee and his heirs and assigns may forever thereafter have hold enjoy and possess the  
same without any suit molestation or interruption by any person whatever lawfully claiming  
any right therein and that they and their executors and administrators will warrant  
and defend the premises and every part thereof unto the said grantee and his heirs and assigns  
forever And that the said grantor and all persons hereafter claiming under him will at any  
time here after at the request and signal of the said grantee or his heirs assignees make all  
such further assurances for the more effectually conveying said premises as may reasonably  
be required In witness whereof the said grantor has hereunto set his hands and seals
