I. QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

The following Questions have been received by the City. Responses are being provided in accordance with the terms of the RFP. Respondents are directed to take note in its review of the documents of the following questions and City responses as they affect work or details in other areas not specifically referenced here.

Question 1: If we chose, would you have an issue with us supplying a new bridge instead of the rehabbing the old one?

Answer 1: A new bridge will be considered as an alternate and the Contractor should submit pricing in accordance with Section III, Part F. A complete description of the item, proposed price differential and revised schedule for installation outside of golf season (April-November) must be included with the alternate proposal. If an alternate new bridge is proposed at Leslie, the design criteria should match the specifications for the Sylvan Bridge.

Question 2: Are our (Bailey Bridges, Incorporated) prefabricated steel bridges from Pioneer Bridges considered an "equal" product to the specified product on the referenced project, as well as for future projects with similar specifications?

Answer 2: Yes, Pioneer Bridges are an "approved equal" for this project, subject to shop drawing review.

Offerors are responsible for any conclusions that they may draw from the information contained in the Addendum.
