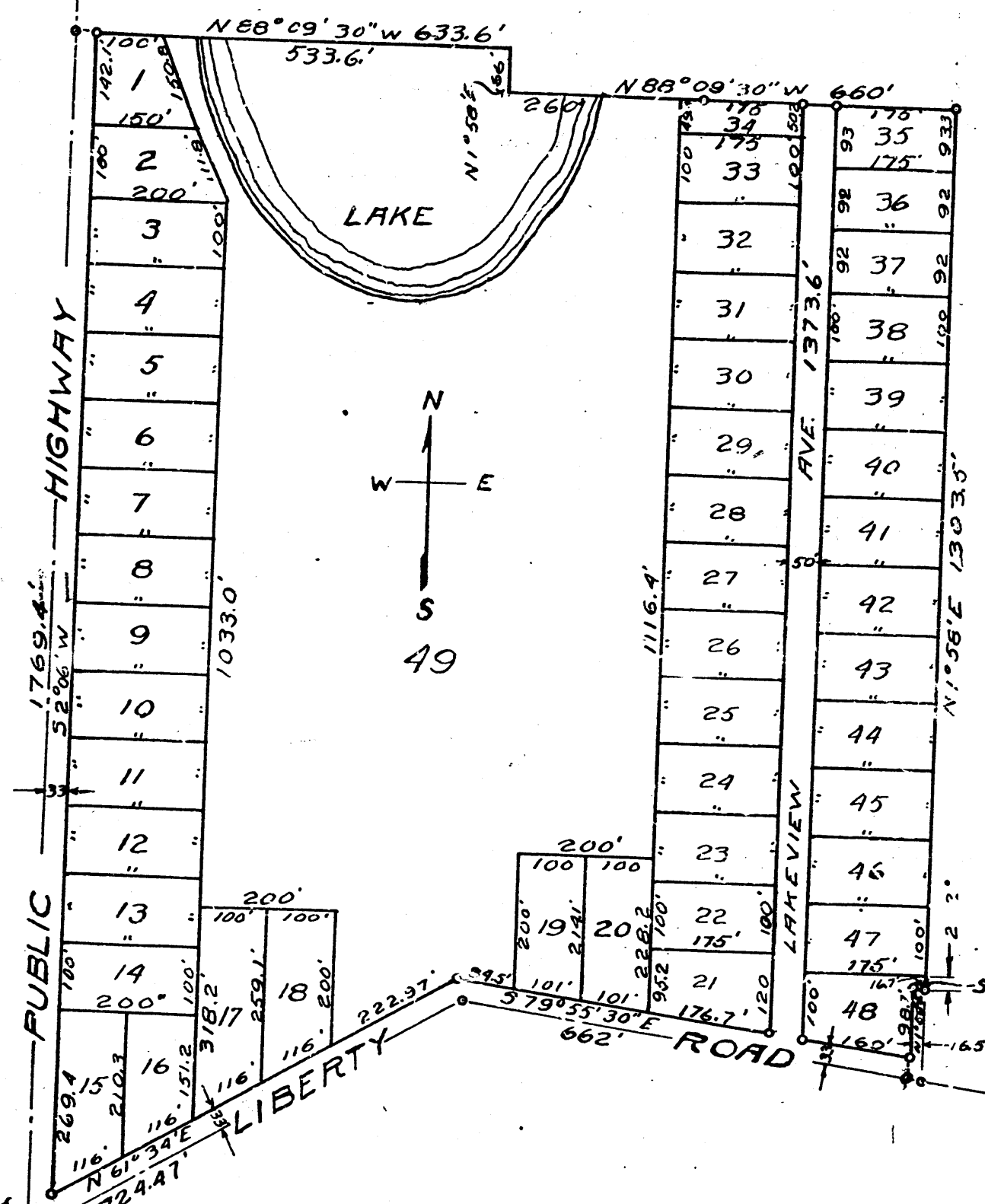
SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

DESCRIPTION

Beginning at an iron pipe in the center of the Liberty Road and on the W line of Section 25 Scio Township, Washtenaw County, Michigan, thence N 61° 34' E 724.47' to an iron pipe thence S 79° 55' 30" E 662.0' thence N 1° 58' E 132' to an iron pipe, thence S 79° 55' 30" E 167' to an iron pipe thence N 1° 58' E 1303.5' to an iron pipe, thence N 88° 9' 30" W 660' thence N 1° 58' E 66' thence N 88° 9' 30" W 633.6' to an iron pipe this being the W 1/2 part of said section 25; thence S 2° 6' W along section line 1769.4' to place of beginning, being that part of the W 1/2 of the SW 1/4 of Sect 25 Township 2, Range 5 E, which lies N of the Eber White Road (now the W. Liberty Street Road) excepting a strip 66' wide and extending W from the N.E. corner of the above described land, 660' and a strip 165' wide and extending N, of the S.E. corner of the said land, 132' containing 44.1 acres more or less
