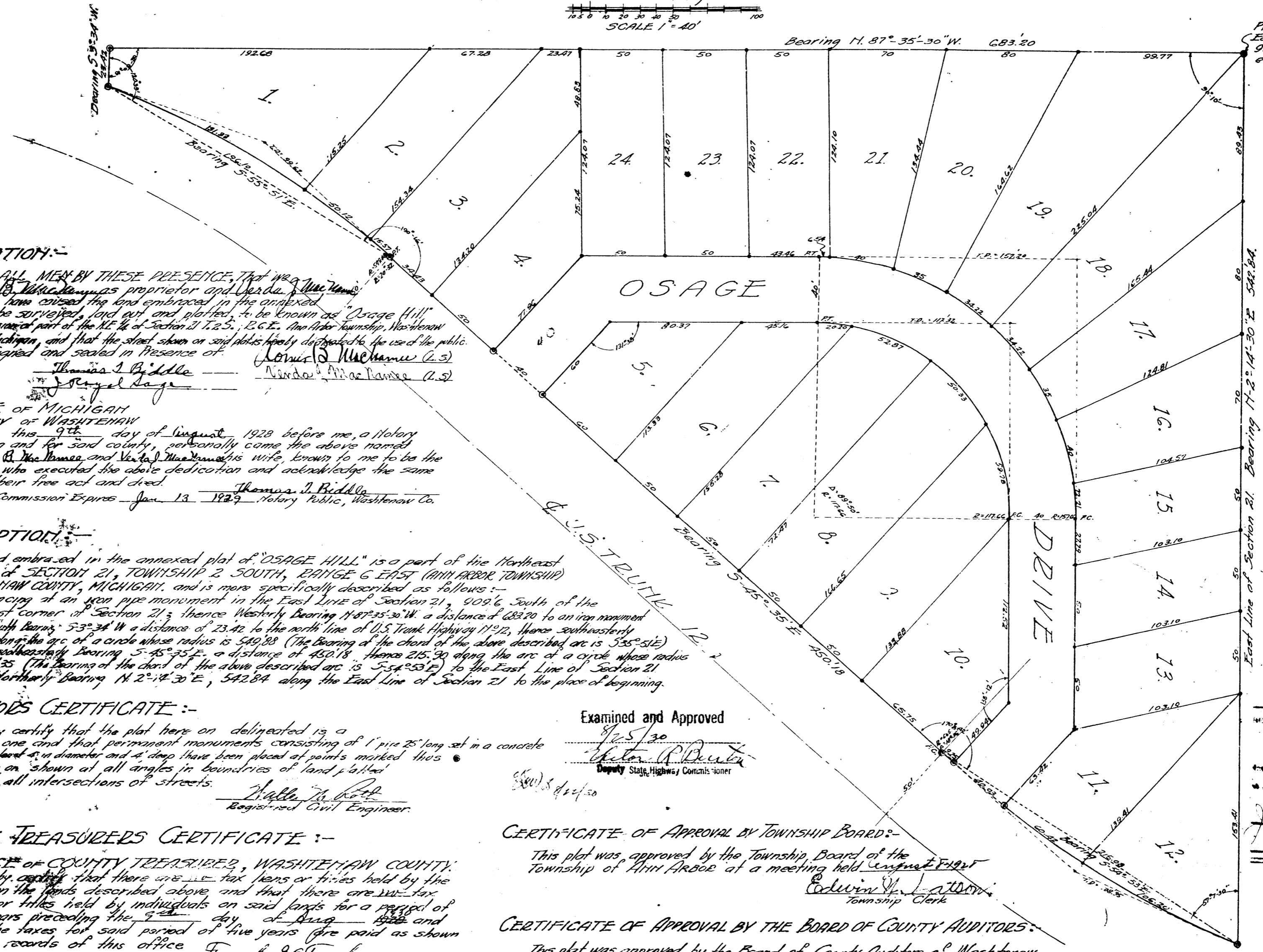
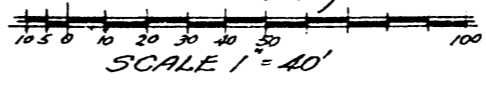


OSAGE HILL

DEDICATION:-

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENCE, that Wm. A. MacNamee (owner) Wm. A. MacNamee proprietor and Verda MacNamee his wife have caused the land embraced in the annexed plat to be surveyed, laid out and plotted to be known as "Osage Hill" a subdivision of part of the NE 1/4 of Section 21, T. 2 S., R. 6 E., Ann Arbor Township, Washtenaw County, Michigan, and that the street shown on said plat is hereby dedicated to the use of the public. DESCRIPTION:-

The land embraced in the annexed plat of "OSAGE HILL" is a part of the Northeast quarter of SECTION 21, TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 6 EAST (ANN ARBOR TOWNSHIP) WASHTEENAW COUNTY, MICHIGAN, and is more specifically described as follows:-
Commencing at an iron pipe monument in the East Line of Section 21, 909.6, South of the Northeast corner of Section 21; thence Westwardly Bearing N 87° 35' 30" W a distance of 683.20 to an iron monument thence South bearing 53° 34' W a distance of 23.42 to the north line of U.S. Trunk Highway 11912, thence Southeastwardly 157.02 along the arc of a circle whose radius is 549.88 (The Bearing of the chord of the above described arc is 53° 52' S1E) thence Southeastwardly Bearing 5° 45' 45" E, a distance of 450.18, thence 215.20 along the arc of a circle whose radius is 15 (65° 35' (The Bearing of the chord of the above described arc is 5° 54' 25" E) to the East Line of Section 21 thence Northwardly Bearing N 2° 14' 30" E, 542.84 along the East Line of Section 21 to the place of beginning.

SURVEYORS CERTIFICATE:-

I hereby certify that the plat here on delineated is a correct one and that permanent monuments consisting of 1 pipe 2 1/2" long set in a concrete base at least 4" in diameter and 4" deep have been placed at points marked thus as here on shown at all angles in boundaries of land plotted and at all intersections of streets.

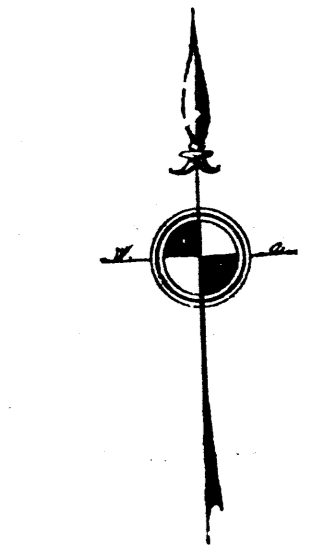
