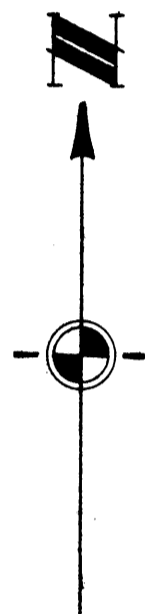

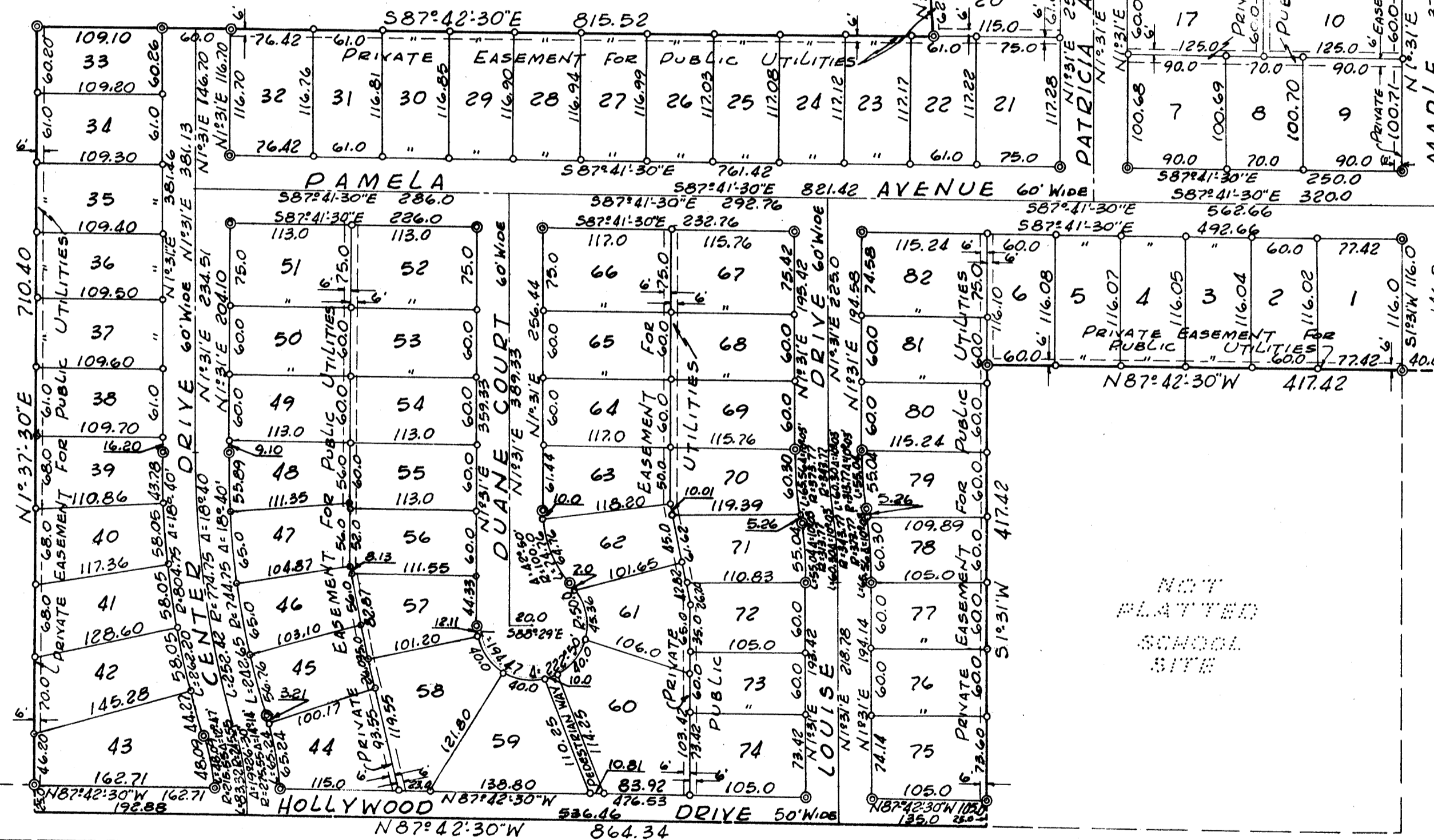

DESCRIPTION OF LAND PLATTED

The land embraced in the annexed plat of HOLLYWOOD PARK a subdivision of part of the SE 1/4 of Section 24, T2S, R5E, City of Ann Arbor, Washtenaw County, Michigan is described as follows:

Commencing at the E 1/4 corner of Section 24, T2S, R5E, Scio Township, Washtenaw County, Michigan; thence along the east line of said Section 24, S 1° -31' W 395.58 feet for a PLACE OF BEGINNING; thence continuing along said east line S 1° -31' W 516.71 feet; thence N 87° -42' -30" W 417.42 feet; thence S 1° -31' W 417.42 feet; thence N 87° -42' -30" W 864.34 feet; thence N 1° -37' -30" E 710.40 feet; thence S 87° -42' -30" E 815.52 feet; thence N 3° -12' -30" W 186.0 feet; thence N 82° -23' E 104.98 feet; thence 194.46 feet in the arc of a circular curve concave to the Southeast, radius 50.0 feet, chord bearing N 70° -00' E 93.05 feet; thence S 1° -31' W 14.9 feet; thence S 87° -42' -30" E 290.0 feet to the place of beginning, containing 82 Lots numbered 1 through 82 inclusive.

I hereby certify that the plat hereon delineated is a correct one and that permanent metal monuments consisting of bars not less than one-half inch in diameter and 36 inches in length, or shorter bars of not less than one-half inch in diameter lapped over each other at least 6 inches with an over-all length of not less than 36 inches, enclosed in a concrete cylinder at least 4 inches in diameter and 36 inches in depth have been placed at points marked thus (⊙) as thereon shown at all angles in the boundaries of the land platted, at all the intersections of lines of streets, and at the intersections of lines of streets with the boundaries of the plat as shown on said plat.
