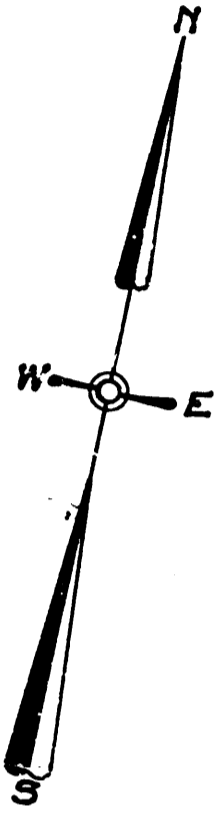
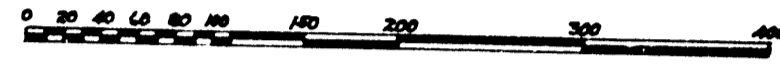


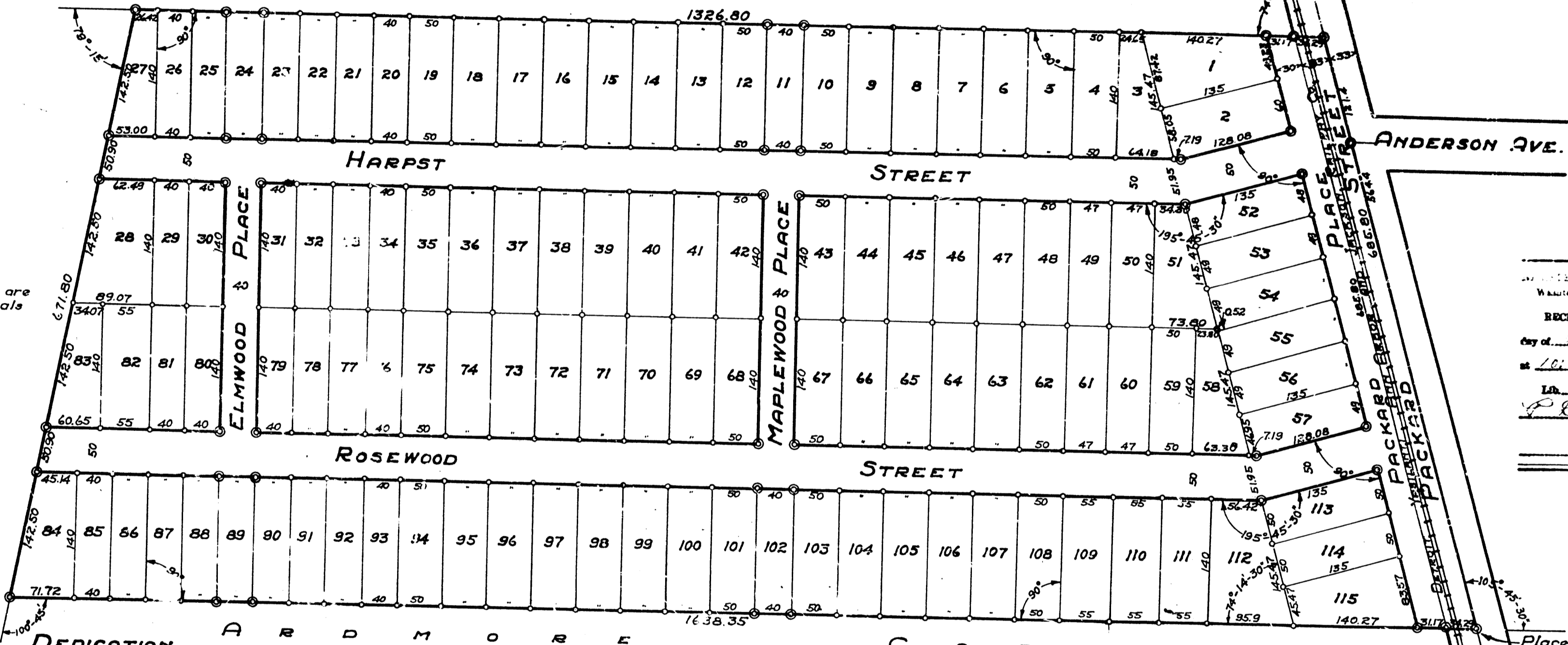
PLAT OF PACKARD HOME SITES

Trennel his wife, Fred Harpst and Rosa Harpst his wife, as proprietors have caused the land embraced in the annexed plat to be surveyed, laid out and platted, to be known as PACKARD HOME SITES a Subdivision of Part of the North One Half of Sec. 4, T. 3 S., R. 6 E., Meridian of Michigan, Pittsfield Township, Washtenaw County, Michigan and that the streets as shown by said plat are hereby dedicated to the use of the public.

DESCRIPTION.
The land embraced in the annexed plat of PACKARD HOME SITES a Subdivision of Part of the North One Half of Sec. 4, T. 3 S., R. 6 E., Meridian of Michigan, Pittsfield Township, Washtenaw County, Michigan is described as follows: Commencing at the intersection of the north line of Ardmore Gardens Subdivision with the center line of Packard Street; thence northwesterly along the center line of Packard Street 685.80 feet; thence deflecting to the left 74°14'30" 1326.80 feet thence deflecting to the left 79°15' 671.80 feet to the northwest corner of said Ardmore Gardens Subdivision; thence deflecting to the left 100°45' on the northerly line of said Ardmore Gardens Subdivision 1638.35 feet to the place of beginning.
