Commencing at an iron stake in the southerly line of Washenaw Ave. 82.50 ft. from the S.W. cor. of Church St. & Washenaw Ave. running thence northwesterly along said line 283.25 ft. to an iron stake; thence - deflecting 137° 38' to the left - parallel to the east line of the west 1/2 of the west 1/2 of sec. 28 T 2 S of R 6 E, 284.30 ft. to an iron stake; thence - deflecting 90° 18' to the left - 123.75 ft. to an iron stake; thence - deflecting 49° 12' to the left - running 100.65 ft. to the place of beginning.

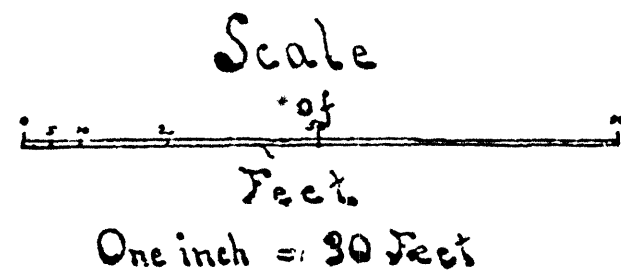

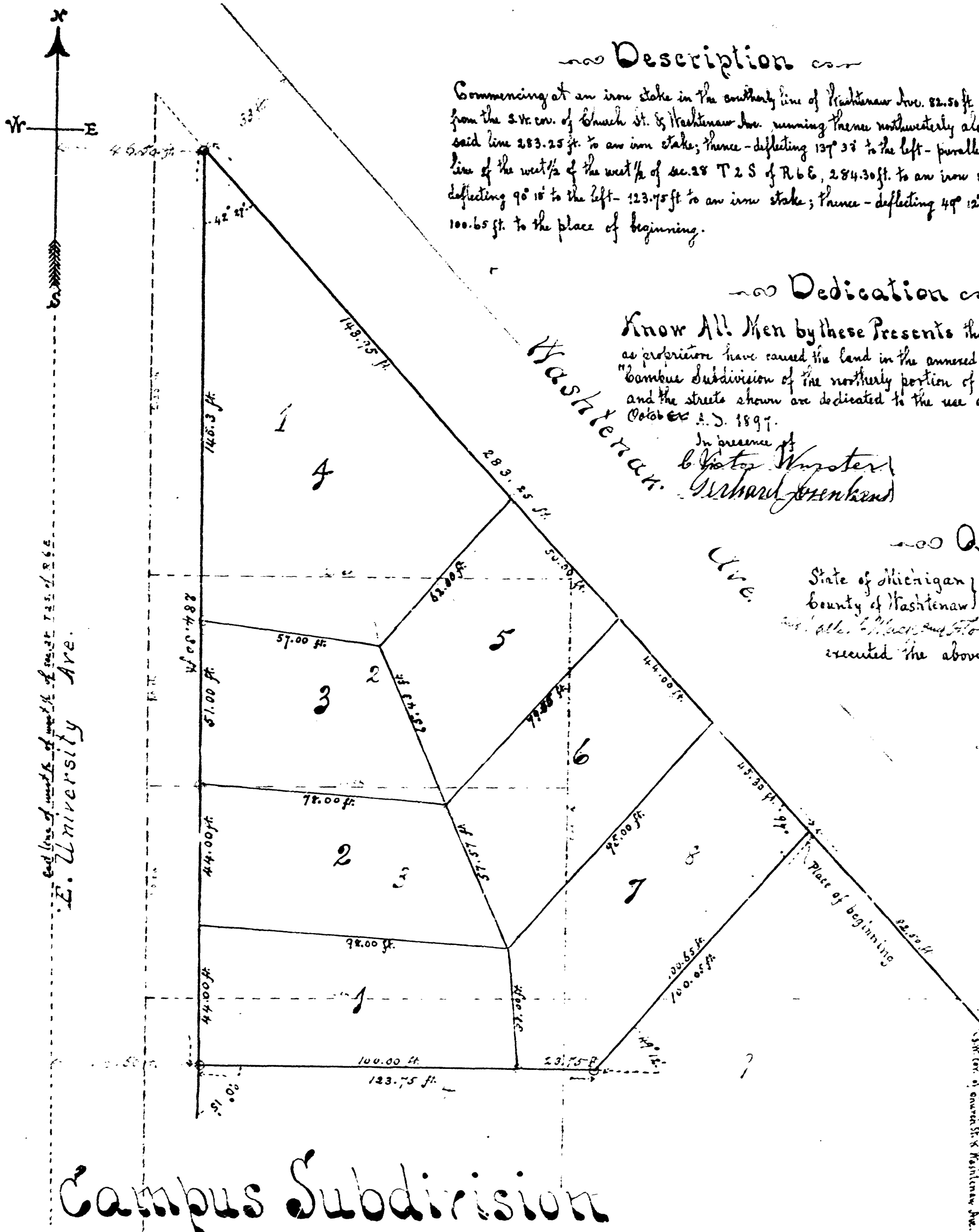
