


Hiscock's Improved Plat



For Deeds see Liber 276 page 111
Book 53.

This Plat is in the North West part of the East half of the South West quarter, and the South West part of the East half of the North West quarterly Section 30 of Township two South of Range six East, and contains Blots number 3, 4, 5, 8, 9 and 10 of Hiscock's addition to the City of Grand Rapids, as laid out and recorded in May 1859 in Liber number 45 on pages 160 and 161.

This improvement or alteration, containing the above Blots into one,

is made by Daniel Hiscock.

and a marked Street the 1st of Spring Street and dividing the Block into 16 lots as represented in number below. All lines are parallel and at right angles to the West line of the Plat.

Field notes given by the Empire Standing Stone and South with West line. Distances given in Chains and links in small figures along the lines. The number of lots are given in the book near the middle of the same. I Peltine Surveyor

I, Daniel Hiscock and Maria Hiscock having made all our hands and seals at the City of Muskegon the 27th day of July AD 1859.
