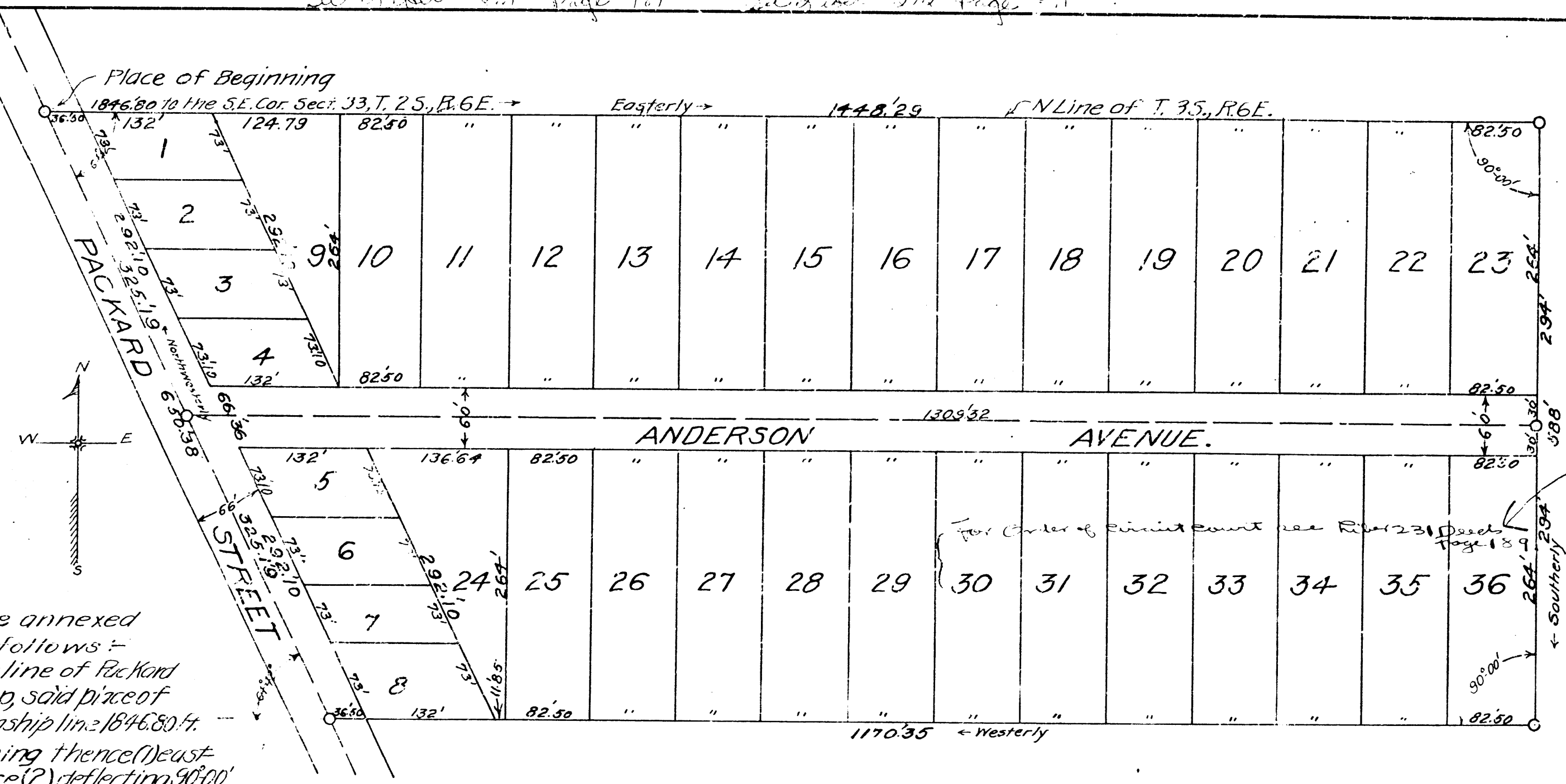

Description:-
 The land embraced in the annexed plat of Eastover Hills is described as follows:-
 Beginning at the intersection of the center line of Packard St. with the north line of Pittsfield Township, said piece of beginning being distant westerly along said township line 1846.80 ft. from the S.E. cor. of Sect. 33, T. 25, R. 6 E.; and running thence (1) easterly along said township line 1448.29 ft.; thence (2) deflecting 90°00' to the right, 588 ft.; thence (3) deflecting 90°00' to the right 1170.35 ft. to the center line of Packard St.; thence (4) deflecting 64°42' to the right along said center line of Packard St. 650.38 ft. to the place of beginning.

 KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, Clellie L. Anderson, as sole proprietor have caused the land embraced in the annexed plat to be surveyed laid out and platted, to be known as EASTOVER HILLS on the N.E. 1/4 of Sect. 4, T. 35, R. 6 E. Washtenaw Co., Mich. and that the streets and alleys as shown on said plat are hereby dedicated to the use of the public.
