Administrative Order to Establish the Jurisdiction of Traffic Civil Infractions Cases Where the Defendant is a Juvenile.

Pursuant to MCL 712A.2e, this administrative order establishes the agreement to determine the courts of jurisdiction for traffic civil infraction cases where the partynamed is under the age of 17.

The Twenty Second Circuit Court waives jurisdiction over all traffic civil infractions alleged to have been committed by juveniles within Washtenaw County and,

Upon execution of this agreement, the 14A, 14B and 15th District Courts shall have jurisdiction over all traffic civil infraction cases naming juveniles and those courts shall proceed in these cases as if the parties named were adults.

Copies of this administrative order and agreement, and any modifications shall be provided to all law enforcement agencies within Washtenaw County, Michigan and to the State Court Administrative Office prior to the effective date.

Traffic civil infraction cases pending in the Family Division of the Washtenaw County Trial Court on the effective date of this order shall not be transferred to the district court having jurisdiction where the alleged incident occurred.
