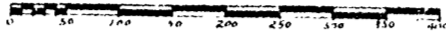


(ORIGINAL)

DESCRIPTION

The land embraced in the annexed plat
 of "DARLINGTON", a subdivision of part of
 the southwest quarter of Section 2, T.3 S.,
 R.6 E., Washtenaw County, Michigan, is descri-
 bed as follows: Commencing at an iron pipe
 at the southwest corner of said section 2;
 thence north along the west line of section
 two 208 feet, thence east 283 feet; thence
 north parallel to the section line 348 feet;
 thence west 283 feet to the west line of said
 section; thence north along the west line of section
 two 210.757 feet to the west quarter post; thence a-
 long the quarter line N. 88° 50' E. 1211.56 feet;
 thence south parallel to the west line 2684.12 feet
 to a point in the south line of section two;
 thence along said section line S. 89° 48' 30" W. 1211 feet to
 the place of beginning.

SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

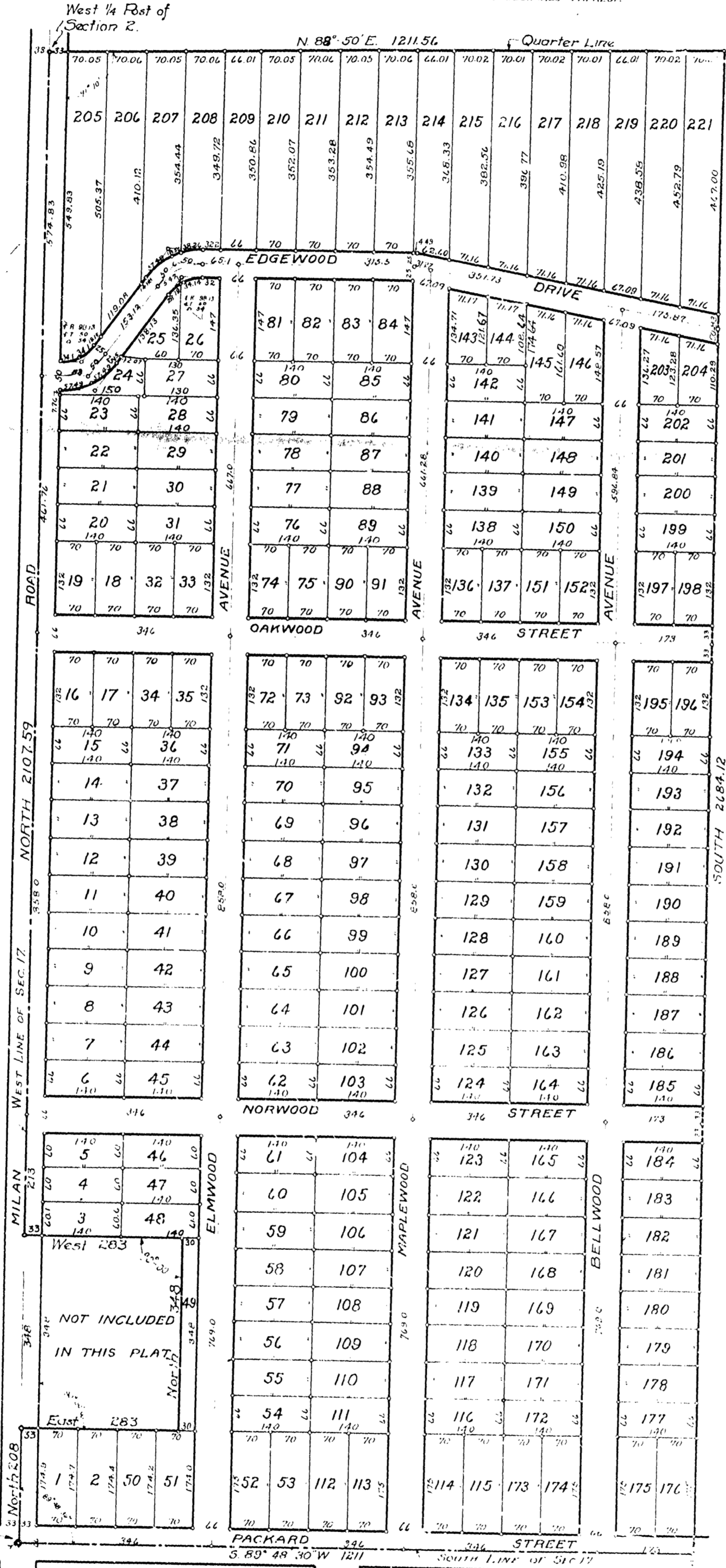
I hereby certify that the plat here-
