DESCRIPTION

The land embraced in the annexed plat of BROCKMAN BOULEVARD HILLS, a subdivision of a part of the southwest quarter of section 34, and the southeast quarter of section 33, T.2 S., R.6 E. in the City of Ann Arbor, Washtenaw Co., Mich., is described as follows:
 Commencing at an iron pipe in the west line of section 34, 66.08 feet south of the west quarter post of said section 34; thence south on the section line 104.80 feet to a point of curve; thence in the arc of a circular curve to the right of radius 41.14 feet through a central angle of 88° 22' 00"; thence south on a line parallel to and 40 feet distant from the west line of section 34, 395.84 feet; thence N. 88° 22' E. 114.60 feet to a point of curve; thence in the arc of a circular curve to the right of radius 249.92 feet through a central angle of 41° 13' to a point of tangency; thence S. 50° 25' E. 103.1 feet to a point in the westerly line of Brockman Boulevard; thence northeasterly in the arc of a circular curve to the right of radius 352.70 feet through a central angle of 2° 40' to a point of tangency, the chord of said arc is 16.37 feet in length and bears N. 51° 05' E.; thence N. 52° 25' E. 51.25 feet to a point of curve; thence in the arc of a circular curve to the left of radius 69.58 feet through a central angle of 52° 00' to a point of tangency; thence N. 00° 25' E. 236.25 feet to a point of curve; thence in the arc of a circular curve to the right of radius 110.95 feet through a central angle of 65° 21' to a point of tangency; thence N. 65° 44' E. 48.80 feet to a point of curve; thence in the arc of a circular curve to the left of radius 44.29 feet through a central angle of 65° 48' to a point of tangency; thence N. 00° 02' W. 101.88 feet to the southeast corner of Buell Subdivision the last described courses being along the westerly line of Brockman Boulevard; thence N. 89° 07' 30" W. along the south line of said Buell Subdivision 467.11 feet to the place of beginning.
