DESCRIPTION.
 The land embraced in the annexed plat of Springwater Subdivision No. 2 is a part of the northeast one-quarter of Section Ten is described as follows: Commencing at a point on the north line of section ten T. 35. R. 6 E. Meridian of Michigan, 693.00 feet west of the northeast corner of said section ten, which point is the northwest corner of Springwater Subdivision No. 1, thence west on the north line of said section ten, 330 feet, thence S 1° 46' 30" W 511.71 feet, thence west parallel to the north line of section ten, 644.6 feet, thence S 1° 44' 14" W 155.2 feet, thence S 69° 57' 00" E 975.88 feet to the southwest corner of Springwater Subdivision No. 1, thence N 1° 46' 30" E on the west line of Springwater Subdivision No. 1, 2065.4 feet to the place of beginning, - excepting therefrom a parcel of land 330 feet in length, east and west, 50 feet in width, the southeast corner of which is the northeast corner of Springwater Subdivision No. 1, which line of section ten is shown by the records of this office.

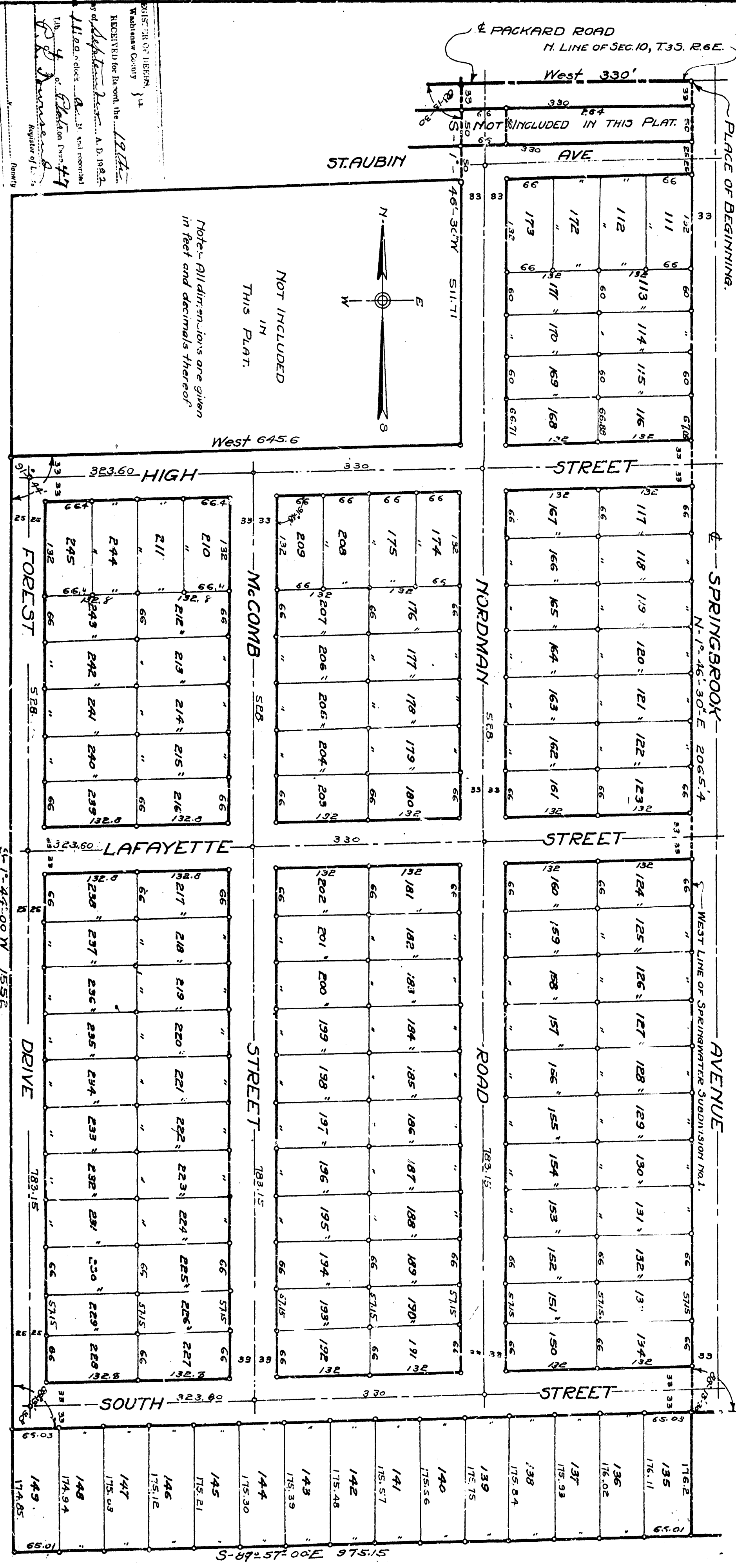
