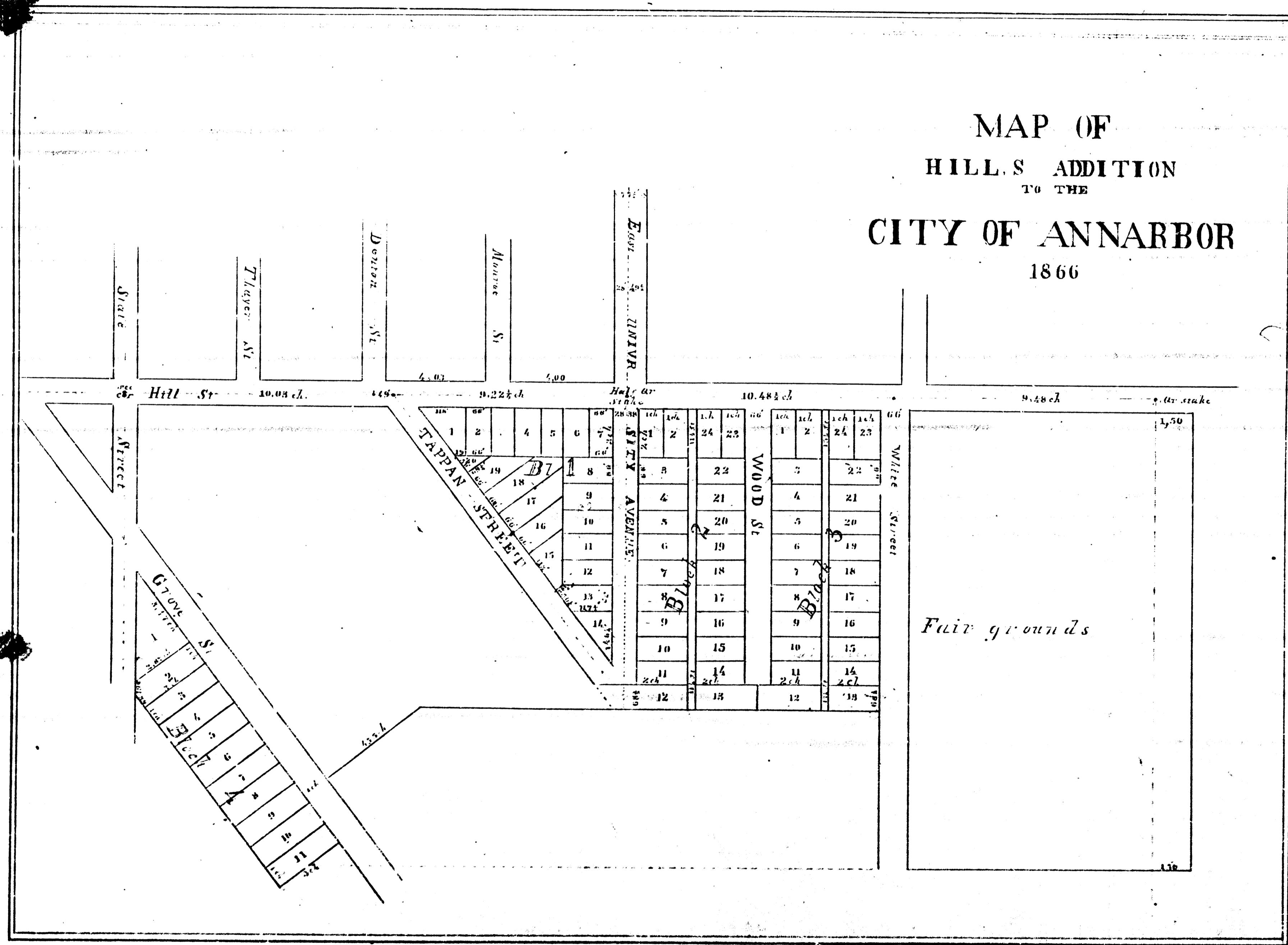


# MAP OF HILL'S ADDITION TO THE CITY OF ANNARBOR 1866

Commenced on the North side of Section 33 D. T. R. & E. in chains level and  
a half links East of the North West corner of said Section, thence East along the  
Section line 20 chains and fifty feet and three quarters links, thence South  
along the West boundary of the Fair Grounds 12 chains and 50 links, thence  
West parallel to the North side of the Section 10 chains 19 1/2 links, thence  
North West to the place of beginning

Also another piece commencing 50 links  
East and chains and links South of the North West corner of the  
same Section, thence South 39 degrees East along the West side of same  
tract 13 chains and 47 links, thence North 51 degrees West 3 chains, thence  
North 39 degrees West 9 chains 29 links, thence North to the place of beginning

In the City of Washington on the 26th day of Nov: 1866, at  
the Court House in the City of Washington, D.C. before me  
George D. Hill and Frances S. Hill, the proprietors of the land upon  
which the said plat is located do hereby adopt and make the same con-  
formable to the Statute made and provided and we do hereby require the  
Record of the said plat in the State of Maryland to be recorded in the  
County of Prince Georges, D.C. Hill do hereby assent to  
said plat, and release all my rights to Down in and to the State highways

In the County of Prince Georges, State of Maryland, on the 12th day of November 1866,  
before me, the undersigned, a Notary Public for said County, personally appeared  
George D. Hill and Frances S. Hill his wife known to me to be the  
persons who adopted, assented to, and executed the within plat and  
the said George D. Hill in that behalf and acknowledged that  
the said plat is his, and dedicated said plat and executed said  
instrument for the purposes aforesaid, and the said Frances  
S. Hill as a joint executrix in her separate and apart from  
her husband, acknowledged that she executed said instrument freely and  
voluntarily from a compulsion from her husband or other person.
