
"GRANGER AND BIXBY ADDITION"

DESCRIPTION.

The land embraced in the annexed plat of Granger and Bixby Addition to the City of Ann Arbor, Washtenaw County, Michigan, is described as follows:-

Beginning at the point of intersection of the Easterly line of Packard Street and the Southerly line of Granger Avenue, thence Easterly along the Southern line of Granger Avenue 703.84 feet to a point marked with an iron pipe monument; thence deflecting 0°-05'-30" to the Right, 1407.64 feet, along the Southern line of Granger Avenue, to a point marked with an iron pipe monument on the Westerly line of Fardon Road; thence deflecting 91°-48'-00" to the Right, 474.00 feet, along the Westerly line of Fardon Road to a point marked with an iron pipe monument; thence deflecting 85°-05'-30" to the Right, 1748.41 feet, to a point marked with an iron pipe monument, on the Easterly line of Packard Street, thence deflecting 53°-55'-00" to the Right, 589.50 feet, along the Easterly line of Packard Street to the point of beginning.

All the above described land lies in the South half of Section 33, Town 2 South, Range 6 East, Meridian of Michigan.
