

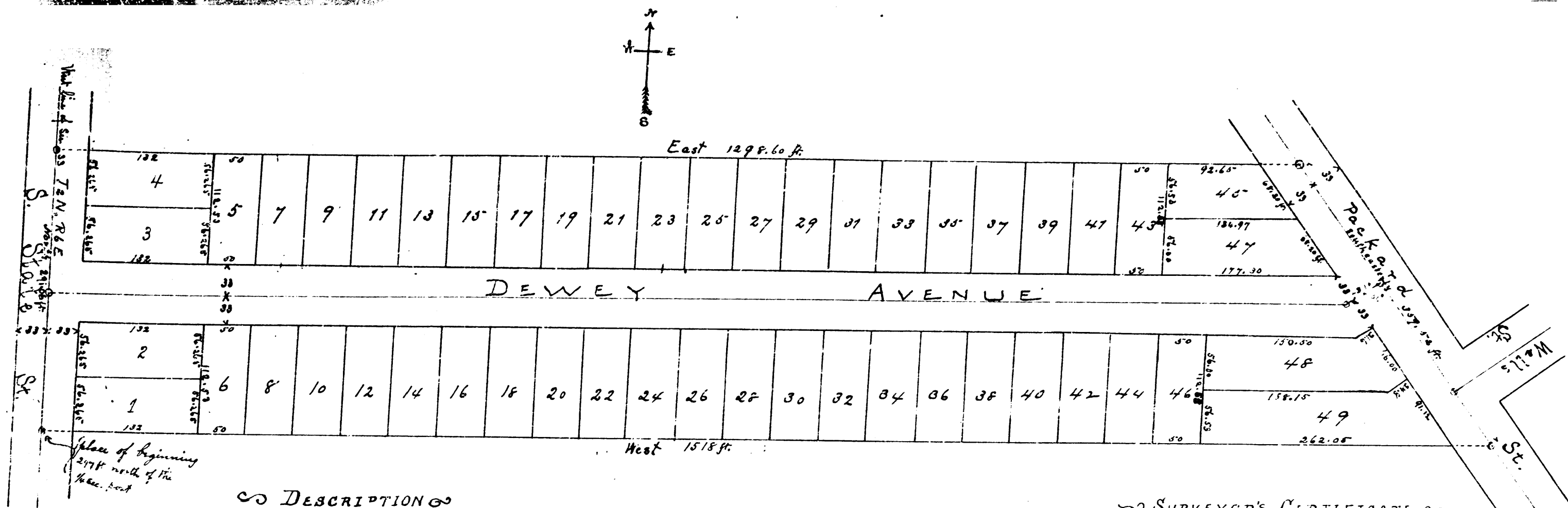

DESCRIPTION

Beginning on the west line of section 33 Town 2 South, Range 6 East, at a point 297 ft. north of the 1/4 sec. post, running thence north along said line 291.06 ft., thence east parallel to the east and west quarter line 1298.60 ft. to the center of the Ypsilanti Road or Richard St, thence southeasterly along the center of said street 359.52 ft., running thence westerly parallel to the east and west quarter line 1518.00 ft. to the place of beginning.
