Description

The land embraced in the annexed plan of White's Addition to the City of Ann Arbor is described as follows: Beginning at a point 95.23 S. of the N.W. corner of Sec. 33, T. 2 S., R. 6 E. measured along the section line; thence, Ely, at a S.W. angle of 90° 03' 00", 131.6'; thence, N.Ely, at a N.W. angle of 90° 22' 30", 43.87'; thence, S.Wly, at a S.W. angle of 89° 37' 30", 231.08'; thence, S.Ely, at an Ely, angle of 89° 37' 30", 112.79'; thence, Sly, at a S.W. angle of 142° 19' 00", 689.69'; thence, Wly, along the section line between Sec. 32 and Sec. 33, 151.6' to the place of beginning.

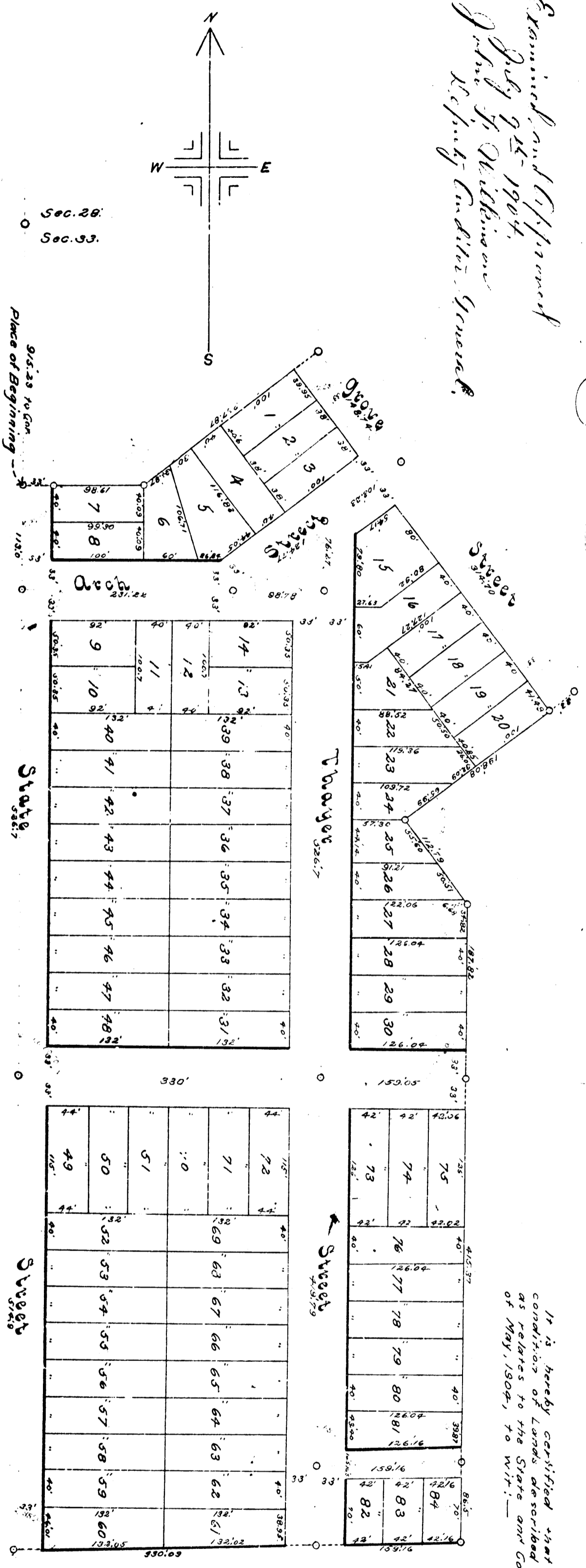
