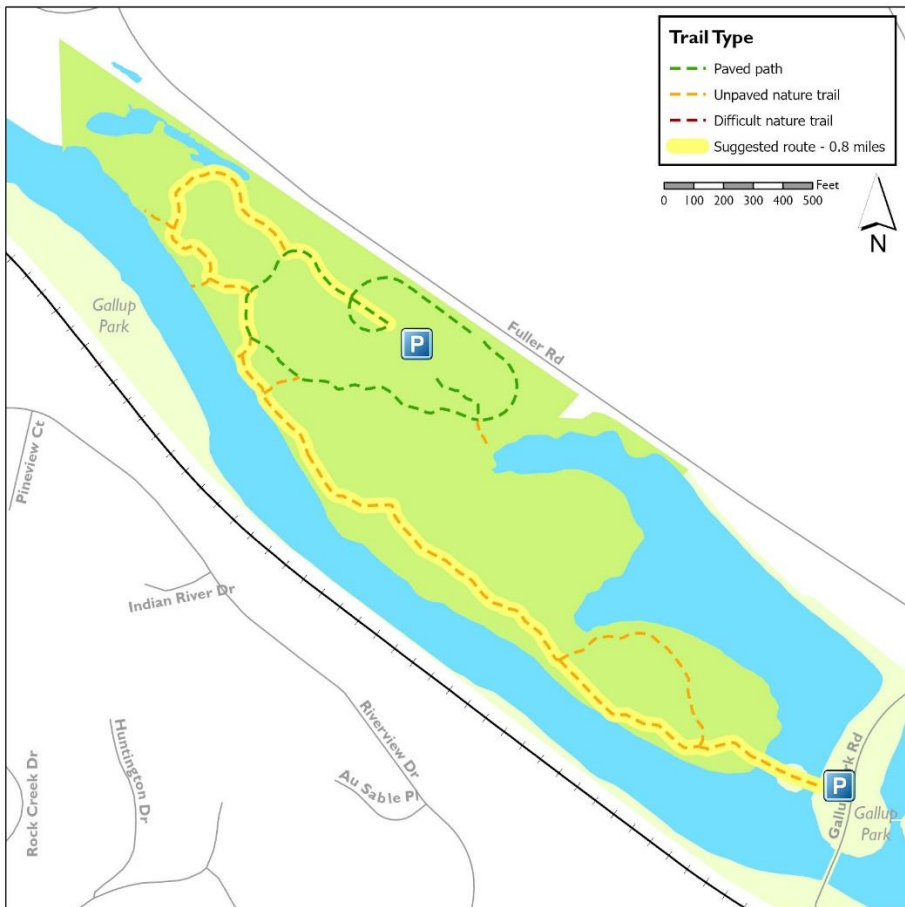
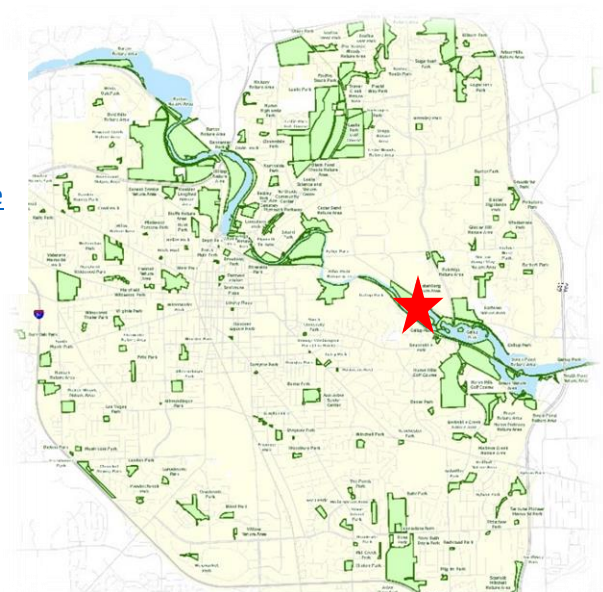




## Furstenberg Nature Area

Furstenberg is a 38-acre natural area bordered by the Huron River and Fuller Road. Gallup Park is just to the southeast, with a boardwalk connecting the two. Due to the variety of different ecosystem found in this park, Furstenberg features the most diverse flora of any park in Ann Arbor. - .8 mile to Gallup
- Total trail: 1.5 miles
