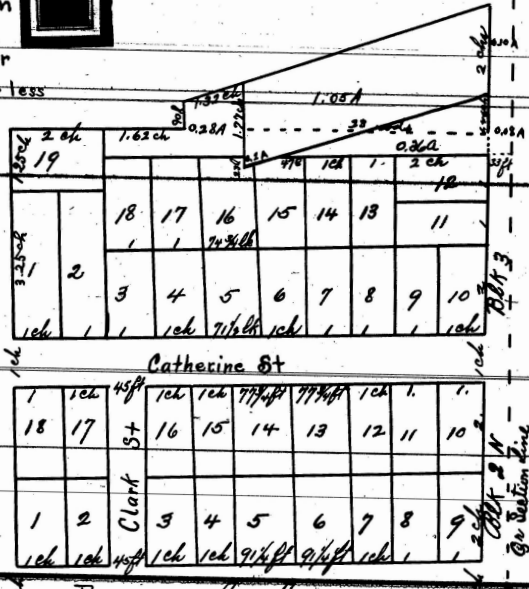

Description of Ingalls Plat of his Addition to the City of Ann Arbor
On the East half of the North West quarter of section 16 28 in Township 10 2 South
of Range 20 6 East in the State of Michigan bounded by a line commencing at the inter-
section of Ann Street with the East line of said quarter section thence West along
Ann Street forty four rods to the East line of Range 20 4 East thence North on the East
line of said Range 20 rods to the center of Catherine Street thence East 4 rods thence North
on Chapman & D. Bruce East line 18 rods to the North line of Oak Street of continued
East thence East on the continuation East of said North line of Oak Street 6 rods and
13 links thence North 90 links thence North easterly to the North West corner of Mrs
Gross land 6 rods & 7 links thence South 8 rods on Mrs Gross West line to her
South West corner thence Easterly 25 rods on Mrs Gross Southern line to the East
line of said quarter section thence South on said quarter line to the place of
beginning about 40 rods containing 9 1/2 acres more or less including and subject
to all Streets thereon.
