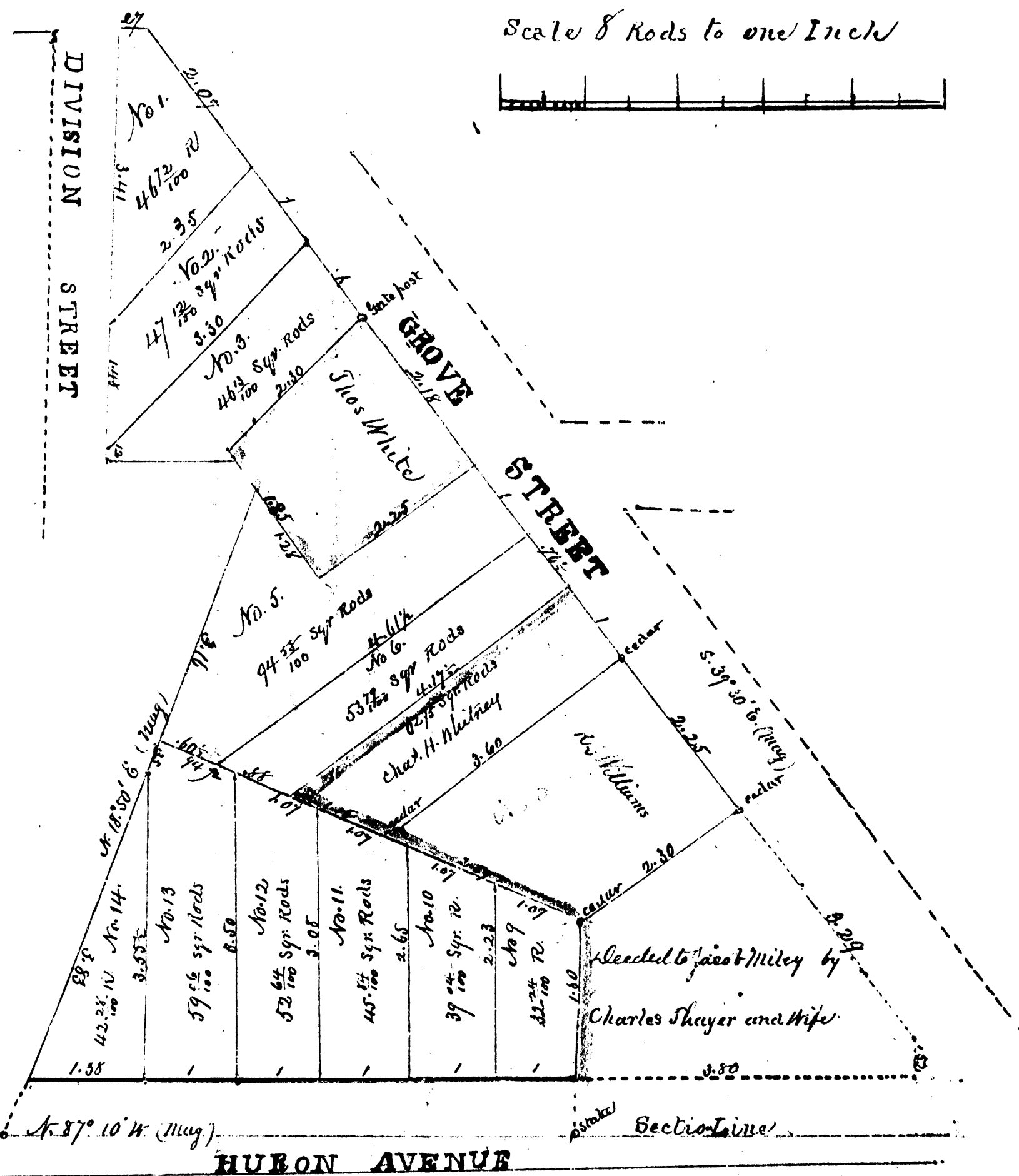


Map

Description of Mellers Addition to New Arbor City

This tract of land is situated in the City of New Arbor State of Michigan and bounded as follows: Five acres in South East part of Section twenty nine in Township Two South Range Six East commencing on the South line of Section twenty two rods West of the South East corner of said Section, thence West on the South line of said Section, ten chains and thirty three links, thence North eight degrees and fifty minutes East, ten chains and fifty links to the South line of Grove Street, thence South East along the line of said Street to the point of beginning, excepting the one acre in the South East corner of said tract sold by Charles Sawyer and wife to Jacob Miller, also excepting the tract of land sold by John Meller and wife to Thomas Shick which is recited in Deed 36 page 174 of Records, also excepting a tract of land sold by John Meller and wife to W. Williams and recorded in Deed 61 Page 29 of Records, also excepting a tract of land sold by John Meller and wife to Charles Whitney.

Description of Mellers Subdivision of a part of Maynard & Morgan's Addition to the City of New Arbor, Michigan. This subdivision consists of Lots C, D, E, F, G, H, I, J, K, L, M, N, O, P, Q, R, S, T, U, V, W, X, Y, Z, and the north two rods of Lot X of Maynard and Morgan's Addition, excepting a small triangle of land on the South East side of said portion of Lot X of Maynard & Morgan's Addition sold by John Meller and wife to Thomas Shick and recorded in Deed 36 Page 174 of Records.

The lots of this addition and subdivision are all fractional. Their measurements are marked in chains and links and their contents in square rods and fractions of square rods.
