- Answer 2: The Lynx system is tied into the output on the controller to release the Larcom South Vestibule door. The police front desk has an icon shortcut on their desktop to open the door. We are not sure what you're referencing with Ademco.
- Question 3: The doors with controllers above the doors. Is a network cable being used to get the controller on the network, and then conductor cable being used to connect the reader, strike, etc.?
- Answer 3: The controller is in the data closet on each floor. The JBoxes above the doors are then wired to the controllers in the closet. There are no controllers above any doors.
- Question 4: What is the model number of the existing readers
- Answer 4: 940, T500 & T520
- Question 5: What card format are you using
- Answer 5: Question #39 on Addendum #1 states "Cards are using CASI F2F proprietary format".

Question 6: Can the existing card readers read F2F and standard HID formats Answer 6: The 940 readers only read F2F format where the T500 and T520 readers can read both F2F and HID.
