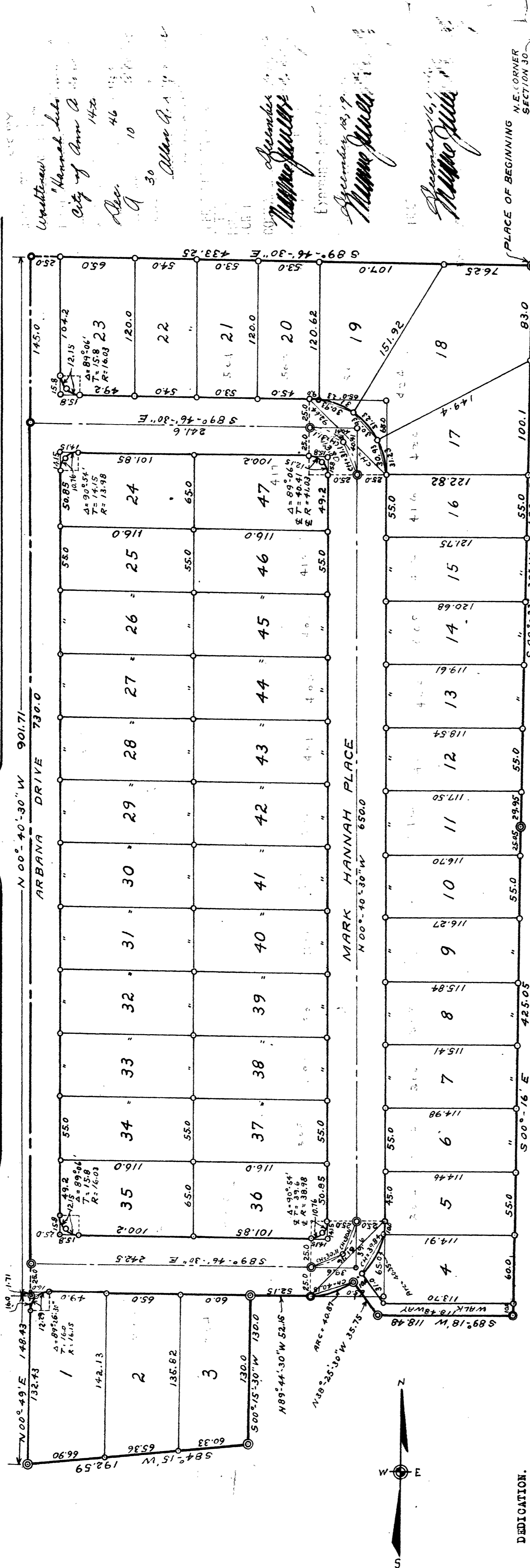


"HANNAH SUBDIVISION"

DESCRIPTION.

The land embraced in the annexed plat of "HANNAH SUBDIVISION, part of east half of east half of north east quarter, Section 30, Town 2 South, Range 6 East, City of Ann Arbor, Washtenaw County, Michigan" is described as follows: Commencing at the northeast corner of Section 30, Town 2 South, Range 6 East, Meridian of Michigan; thence south 00°-23'-30" west in the east line of said section 200.34 feet FOR A PLACE OF BEGINNING; thence south 00°-23'-30" west in said section line 488.05 feet; thence south 00°-16' east 425.05 feet; thence south 89°-18' west 118.48 feet; thence north 38°-25'-30" west 35.75 feet to a point of curve; thence southerly in the arc of a circular curve, convex southerly, of radius 63.98 feet a distance of 40.87 feet to a point of tangency, the chord subtended by said arc being 40.18 feet in length and bears south 71°-41'-30" west; thence north 89°-44'-30" west along the tangent to the above curve 52.15 feet; thence south 00°-15'-30" west 130.00 feet; thence south 84°-15' west 192.59 feet to the east line of Waldwood Park Addition Number One; thence north 00°-49' east 148.43 feet along said east line; thence north 00°-40'-30" west 901.71 feet; thence south 89°-45'-30" east 437.25 feet to the place of beginning, being a part of the northeast quarter of Section 30, Ann Arbor Township, Washtenaw County, Michigan and located within the city limits of Ann Arbor.

SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE.

I hereby certify that the plat hereon delineated is a correct one and that permanent metal monuments consisting of bars not less than one-half inch in diameter and 48 inches in length, or shorter bars of not less than one-half inch in diameter lapped over each other at least 6 inches with an over-all length of not less than 48 inches, encased in a concrete cylinder at least 4 inches in diameter and 48 inches in depth have been placed at points marked thus @ as thereon shown at all angles in the boundaries of the land platted, at all intersections of streets, intersections of alleys, or of streets and alleys, and at intersections of streets and alleys with the boundaries of the plat as shown on said plat.
