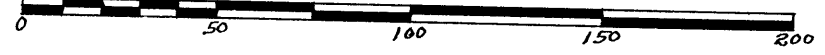


"WILDWOOD PARK ADDITION NUMBER TWO"

SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

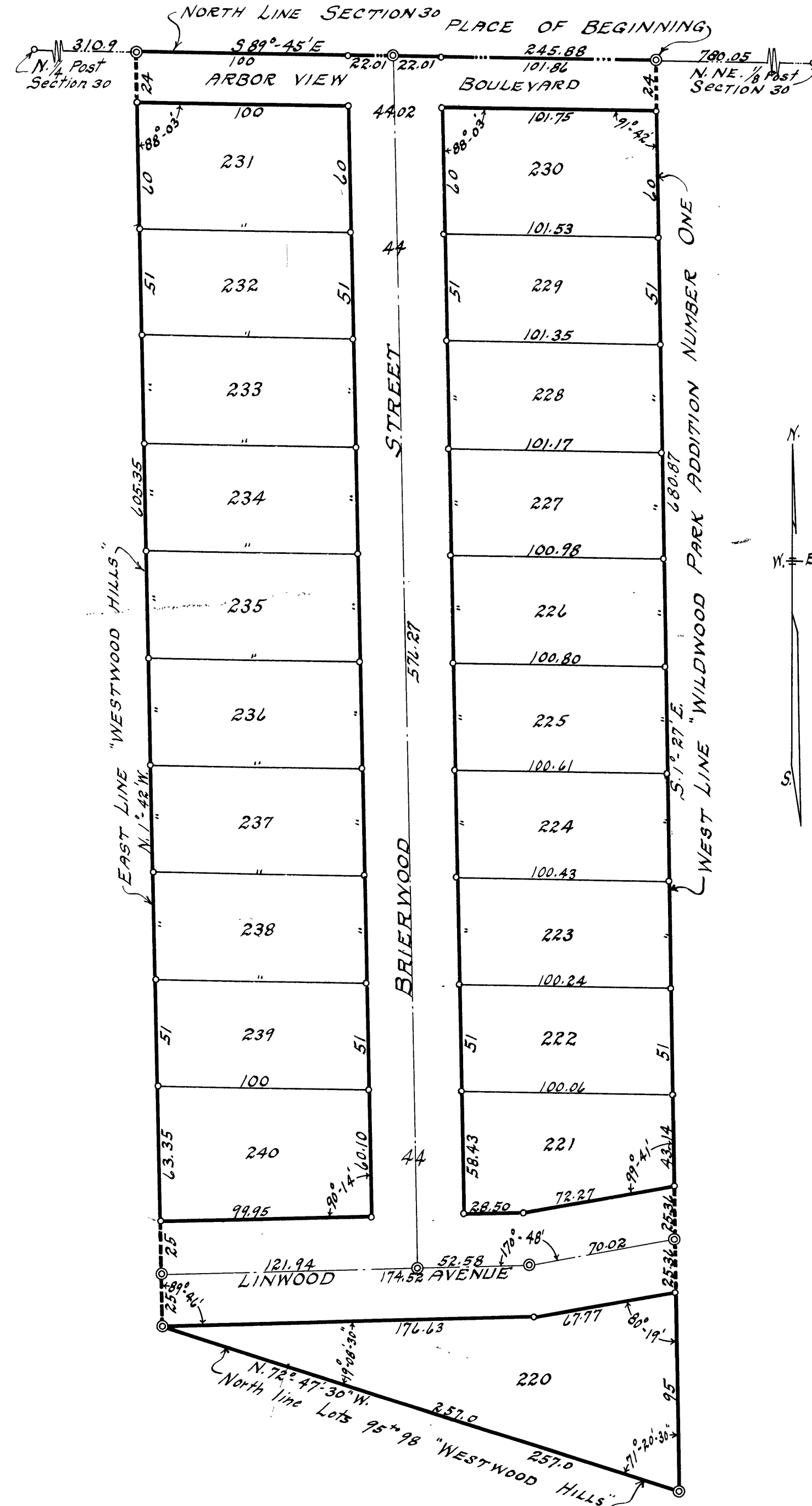

DESCRIPTION

The land embraced in the annexed plat of "WILDWOOD PARK ADDITION NUMBER TWO", part of the west half of the northeast quarter section 30, Ann Arbor Township, in the City of Ann Arbor, Washtenaw County, Michigan, is described as follows: Commencing at an iron pipe monument in the north line of section 30, 780.05 feet west of the north, northeast eighth post section 30, town two south, range six east, Washtenaw County, Michigan; thence S. 1°-27' E. along the west line of "Wildwood Park Addition Number One" 680.87 feet; thence N. 72°-47'-30" W. along the north line of Lots 95 to 98 of "Westwood Hills"; 257.00 feet; thence N. 1°-42' W. along the east line of "Westwood Hills" 605.35 feet to an iron pipe monument in the north line of section 30, which is 310.9 feet east of the north quarter post of section 30; thence S. 89°-45' E. along the north line of section 30, 245.88 feet to the place of beginning.

Note: All dimensions are given in feet and decimals thereof.
