DESCRIPTION

The land embraced in the annexed plat is described as follows:-

Beginning at the southeast corner of Lot 51, Block 3 of Assessor's Plat No. 3 in the City of Ann Arbor, Mich., filed in the office of the Register of Deeds of Washtenaw Co., Mich., said point being on the north line of W. Liberty St.; thence south 74°-22' W. along the N. Line of W. Liberty St. 315.65 ft. to the southeast corner of Jewett's Addition; thence north 2°-11' W., 188.4 ft. along the east line of Jewett's Addition; thence north 1°-33'-30" W., 301.8 ft. along the east line of Jewett's Addition continued; thence north 88°-26'-30" E., 220 ft.; thence south 1°-33'-30" E., 289.45 ft.; thence north 88°-26'-30" E., 87.83 ft. to the west line of Lot 50, Block 3 of Assessor's Plat No. 3 in the City of Ann Arbor, Washtenaw Co., Mich., thence south 1°-33'-30" E. 125.0 ft. along the line between Lots 50 and 51 to the place of beginning; said parcel of land being on the W. 1/2 of Sec. 29, T. 2 S., R. 6 E. meridian of Michigan.

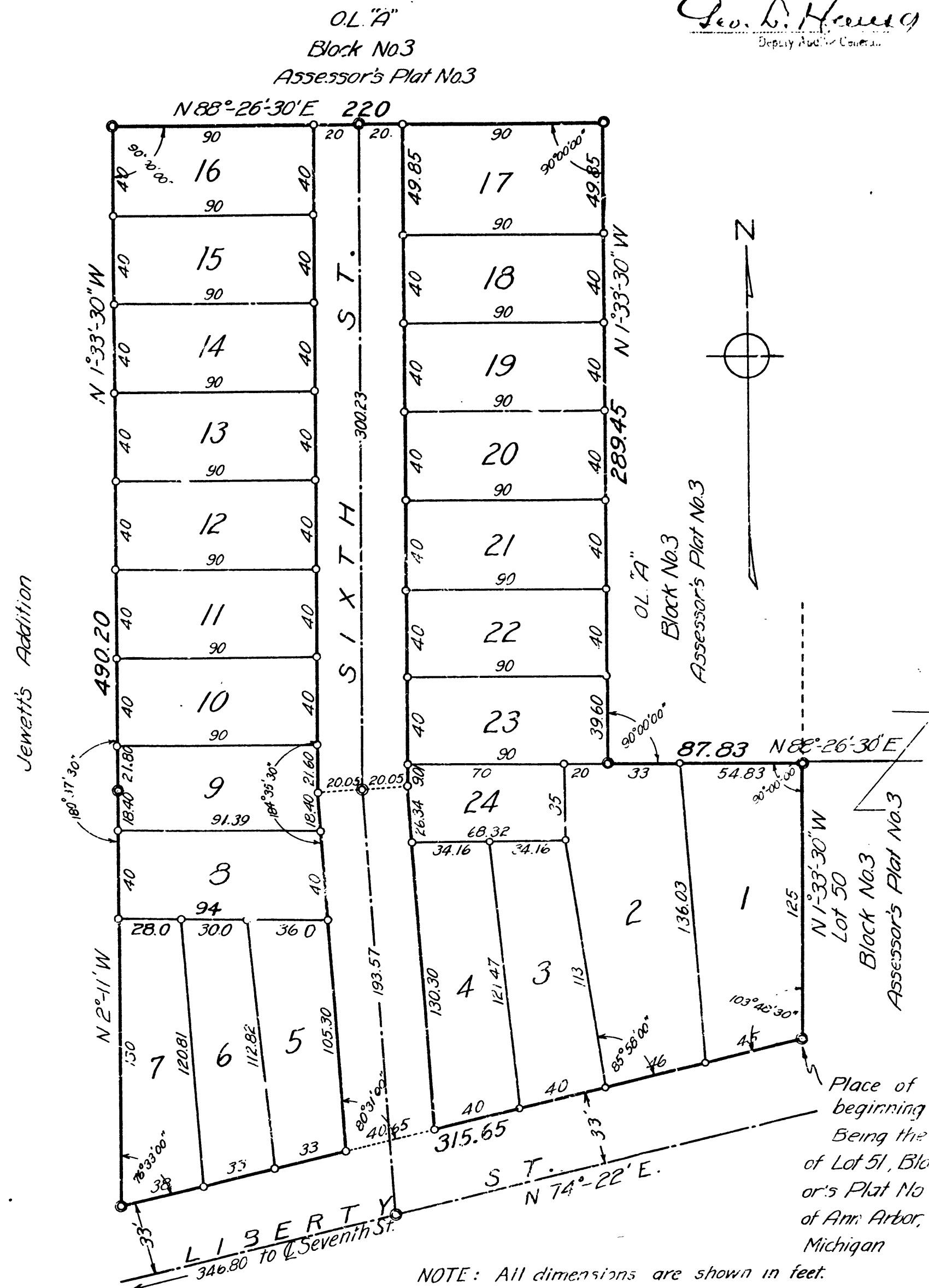
