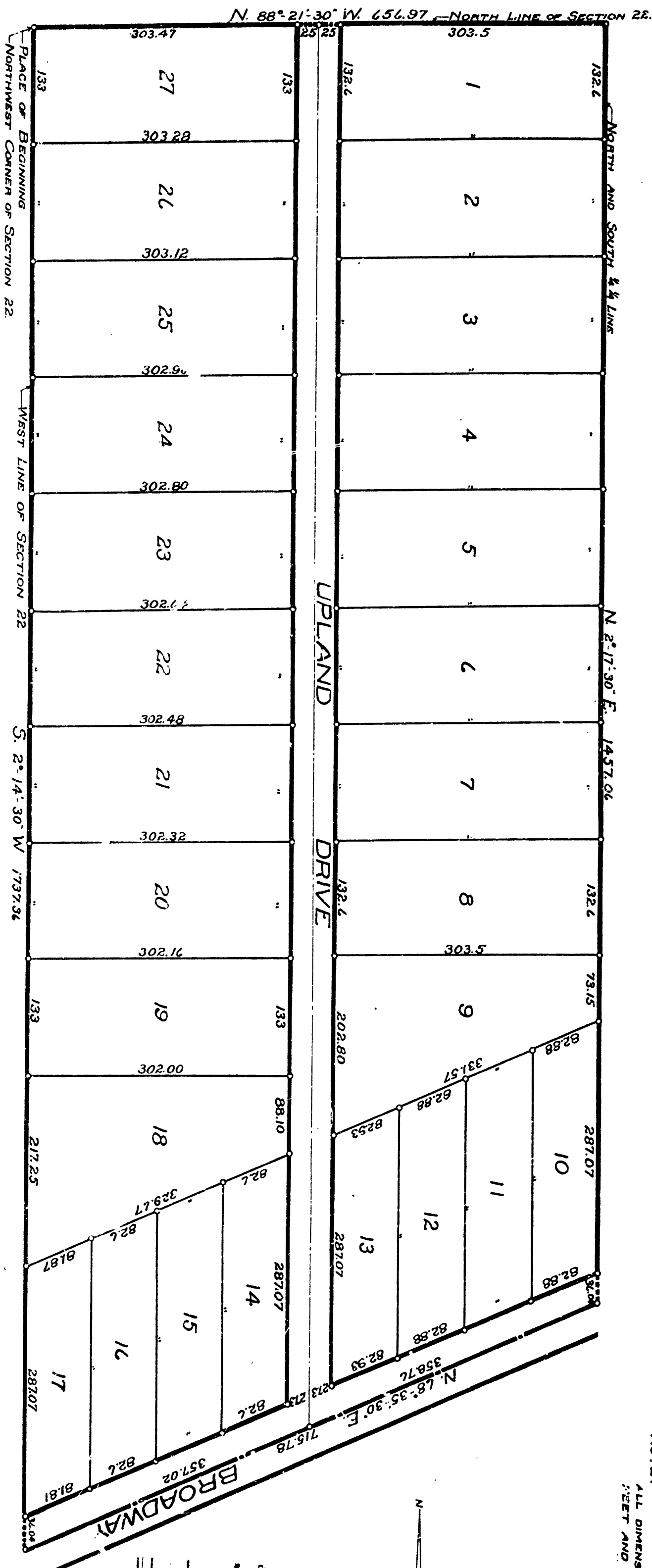


# UPLANDS

DESCRIPTION  
The land embraced in the annexed plat of "UPLANDS" a subdivision  
of a part of the northwest one-quarter of section 22, Ann Arbor Town-  
ship, Washtenaw County, Michigan, is described as follows: commencing  
at the northwest corner of section 22 in Ann Arbor Township, Washtenaw  
County, Michigan; thence south 2° - 14' - 30" west 1737.36 feet along the  
west line of section 22 to the center line of Broadway; thence north  
68° - 35' - 30" east 725.78 feet along the center line of Broadway;  
thence north 2° - 14' - 30" east 1457.06 feet along the north and south  
one-quarter one-quarter line to the north line of section 22; thence  
north 88° - 21' - 30" west 656.97 feet along the north line of section  
22 to the place of beginning.
