DESCRIPTION

The land embraced in the annexed plat of "ANN ARBOR HILLS" a subdivision in sections thirty four and thirty five Ann Arbor Township and in sections two and three Pittsfield Township is described as follows: commencing at the east quarter post of section thirty four, town two south, range six east, Meridian of Michigan; thence S. 1° - 19' E. along the section line 660 feet; thence N. 88° - 41' E. 165 feet; thence S. 1° - 19' E. 1608.2 feet; thence N. 86° - 37' - 30" W. 42.27 feet; thence S. 17° - 58' - 30" E. 262.07 feet to a point of curve; thence along the arc of a circular curve to the right of radius 552.2 feet through a central angle of 16° - 43' - 16" to a point in the north line of section two Pittsfield Township at 30 feet N. 88° - 07' E. of the northwest corner of said section two of Pittsfield Township; thence S. 1° - 15' - 20" E. parallel with the section line and 30 feet distant therefrom 255.73 feet to the center line of Washtenaw Road as surveyed by the State Highway Department; thence N. 73° - 58' - 20" W. along said center line of Washtenaw Road 83.78 feet; thence N. 1° - 15' - 20" W. 229.59 feet to a point in the townline 50 feet S. 87° - 42' W. of the northeast corner of section 3 Pittsfield Township; thence S. 87° - 42' W. along the townline 141.05 feet to the southeast corner of section 34 Ann Arbor Township; thence S. 86° - 16' W. along the town line 620 feet to a point in the center line of Washtenaw Road, said point being in the arc of a circular curve, concave to the south, of radius 8617.9 feet and central angle of 6° - 07' at a chord length of 495.05 feet distant westerly from the easterly beginning of said curve; thence northerly along the arc of said last described circular curve to the left through a central angle of 2° - 49' - 30" to the westerly end of said curve; the chord to said arc being 425 feet in length and bearing N. 78° - 39' W.; thence continuing in the center line of Washtenaw Road, N. 86° - 03' - 40" W. 1362.9 feet to a point of curve; thence along the arc of a circular curve to the right of radius 1146.75 feet through a central angle of 15° - 20' to the intersection of the center line of Washtenaw Road with the north and south quarter line of section 34 Ann Arbor Township; thence N. 60° - 28' - 20" W. along said quarter line 2206.2 feet to the center post of said section 34; thence N. 88° - 17' - 7" E. along the east and west quarter line 1102.2 feet; thence N. 00° - 06' - 10" E. 154.76 feet; thence N. 5° - 16' - 10" W. 163.77 feet; thence N. 84° - 43' - 50" E. 139.8 feet; to a point of curve; thence along the arc of a circular curve to the left of radius 615.45 feet through a central angle of 11° - 50'; thence S. 0° - 45' - 10" E. 361.2 feet to a point in the east and west quarter line; thence N. 88° - 17' - 20" E. along the quarter line 1048.7 feet to the place of beginning.


