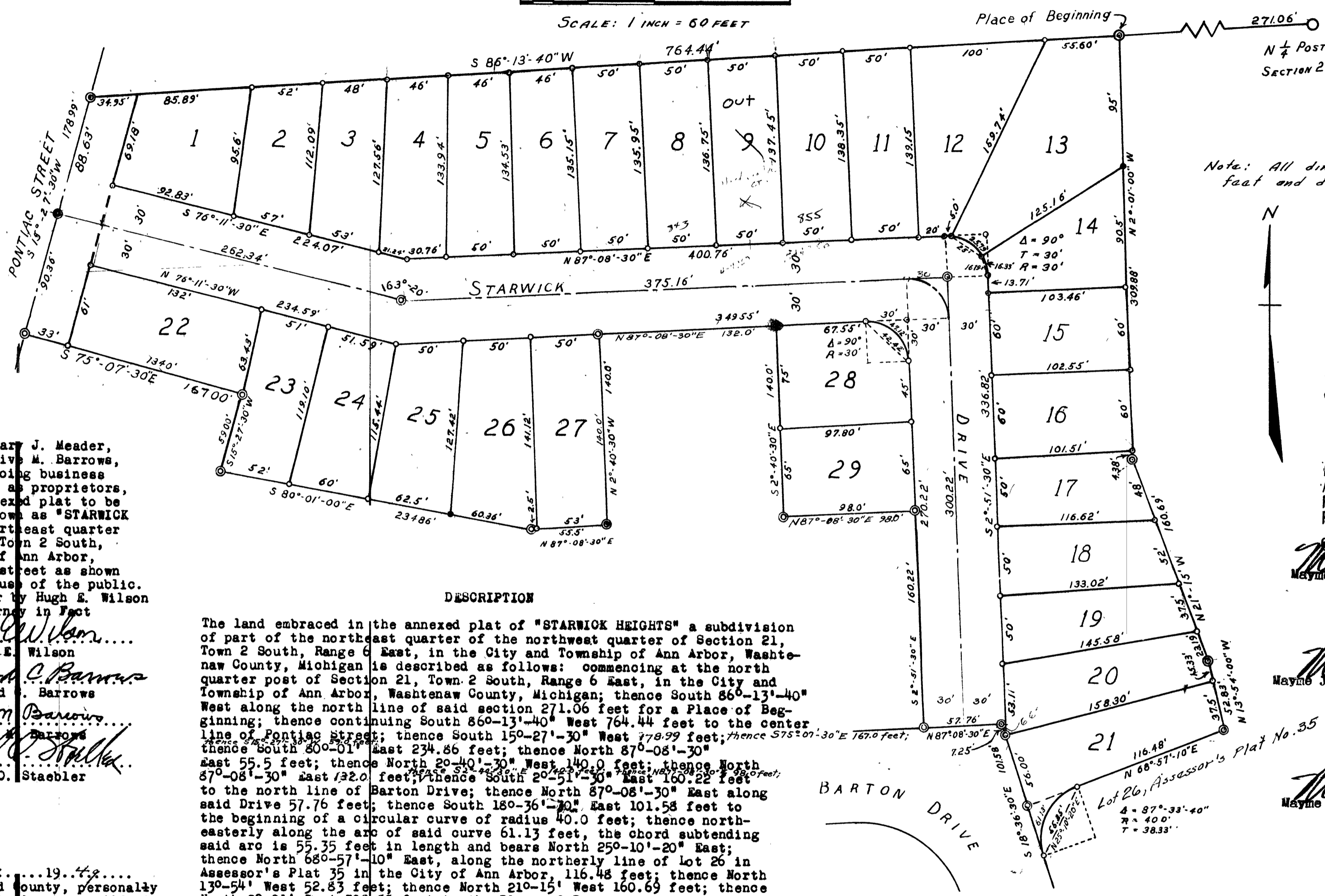
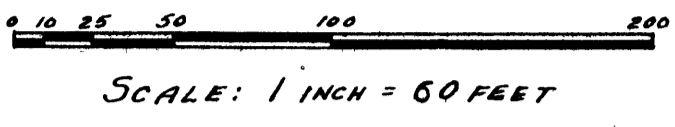

DESCRIPTION

The land embraced in the annexed plat of "STARWICK HEIGHTS" a subdivision
 of part of the northeast quarter of the northwest quarter of Section 21,
 Town 2 South, Range 6 East, in the City and Township of Ann Arbor, Washtenaw
 County, Michigan is described as follows: commencing at the north
 quarter post of Section 21, Town 2 South, Range 6 East, in the City and
 Township of Ann Arbor, Washtenaw County, Michigan; thence South 86°-13'-40"
 West along the north line of said section 271.06 feet to a Place of Begin-
 ning; thence continuing South 86°-13'-40" West 764.44 feet to the center
 line of Pontiac Street; thence South 15°-27'-30" West 178.99 feet; thence
 South 80°-01' East 234.86 feet; thence North 87°-08'-30" East 55.5 feet;
 thence North 20°-40'-30" West 140.0 feet; thence North
 87°-08'-30" East 132.0 feet; thence South 20°-51'-30" East 160.22 feet
 to the north line of Barton Drive; thence North 87°-08'-30" East along
 said Drive 57.76 feet; thence South 18°-36'-20" East 101.53 feet to
 the beginning of a circular curve of radius 40.0 feet; thence north-
 easterly along the arc of said curve 61.13 feet, the chord subtending
 said arc is 55.35 feet in length and bears North 25°-10'-20" East;
 thence North 68°-57'-10" East, along the northerly line of Lot 26 in
 Assessor's Plat 35 in the City of Ann Arbor, 116.48 feet; thence North
 13°-54' West 52.83 feet; thence North 21°-15' West 160.69 feet; thence
 North 20°-01' West 309.88 feet to the Place of Beginning; being a part of
 the northeast quarter of the northwest quarter of Section 21, Ann Arbor
 Township, Washtenaw County, Michigan.
