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HURON RIVER HILLS
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DESCRIPTION
The land embraced in the annexed plat of "HURON RIVER HILLS" a subdivision of part of the southwest quarter section 16, Ann Arbor Township, Washtenaw County, Michigan, is described as follows: Commencing at the intersection of the south line of section 16, Ann Arbor Township, Washtenaw County, Michigan with the center line of Pontiac Street, said point being the northeast corner of the recorded plat of "Riverview Acres"; thence S. 87° - 16' - 30" W. along the south line of said section 16, 1245 feet; thence N. 38° - 36" W. 11.24 feet; thence N. 58° - 17' W. 99 feet; thence N. 45° - 15' W. 122.80 feet to a point of curve; thence in the arc of a circular curve to the right of radius 26.26 feet, through a central angle of 121° - 02' to the point of tangency; thence N. 75° - 47' E. 39.49 feet; thence S. 89° - 06' E. 79.53 feet; thence S. 71° - 57' E. 96.98 feet to a point of curve; thence in the arc of a circular curve to the left of radius 81.18 feet, through a central angle of 49° - 43' to the point of tangency; thence N. 58° - 15' E. 20.53 feet; thence N. 38° - 13' E. 66.14 feet; thence N. 3° - 33' W. 1.38 feet; thence N. 28° - 03' W. 59.6 feet; thence N. 32° - 07' - 30" W. 14.83 feet; thence N. 74° 06' - 30" W. 31.13 feet; thence N. 80° - 07' - 30" W. 174.05 feet; thence S. 84° - 20' - 30" W. 1.66 feet; thence S. 08° - 14' - 30" W. 159.63 feet; thence N. 00° - 27' W. 977.81 feet; thence S. 85° - 26' - 30" E. 410.37 feet; thence S. 4° - 31' - 30" W. 50.37 feet; thence S. 81° - 33' - 30" E. 226.91 feet; thence S. 13° - 18' - 30" W. 75 feet; thence S. 20° - 21' - 30" E. 217.44 feet; thence S. 13° - 15' - 30" W. 1.33 feet; thence S. 82° - 05' - 00" E. 567.82 feet; thence N. 75° - 32' - 30" E. 86.16 feet; thence S. 08° - 06' - 30" E. 258 feet, to the center line of Pontiac Street; thence N. 1° - 53' - 30" W. along said center line 656.71 feet, thence continuing along said center line S. 10° - 30' W. 96.76 feet to the place of beginning.
