


MISS ELISABETH C. ALMENDINGER'S ADDITION TO THE CITY OF ANN ARBOR MICHIGAN.

DESCRIPTION OF LAND PLATTED.

Beginning at a point on the east and west half
quarter line of the north east quarter of section
thirty two (32) of township two (2) south of
range six (6) east, Meridian of Michigan, three
hundred and eighty seven and one tenth (387.00)
feet west of the center of said quarter section;
thence northerly deflecting 10° 45' 20" to the right
two hundred and forty five feet and forty five hundredths
(265.45) feet to the south east corner of Brown
and Bach's Addition; thence westerly deflecting
90° 45' 20" to the left three hundred and thirty (330)
feet along the south line of said addition; thence
northerly deflecting 10° 45' 20" to the left, three
hundred and ninety six (396) feet; thence easterly
parallel to the south line of Brown and Bach's
addition three hundred and thirty (330) feet; thence
northerly on the line of the course bearing the
place of beginning, one hundred and thirty and
fifty six hundredths (130.56) feet to the place of
beginning, the same being a parallelogram
three hundred and ninety six (396) feet long
northerly and southerly by three hundred and thirty (330)
feet wide, containing about three (3) acres of land.

EXPLANATIONS.

Monuments of iron, stone and brick at the
corners, marked \odot also marked by white oak
stakes two inches square and two feet long. Dimensions
in feet.
