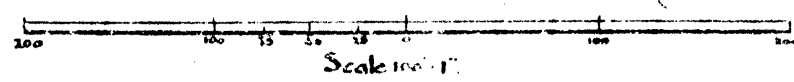


# HAMILTON, ROSE AND SHEEHAN'S ADDITION

TO THE  
City and Town of Ann Arbor,  
Washtenaw Co., Mich.

SECT. 33, T. 2 S. R. 6 E.



The land embraced in the annexed plat of Hamilton, Rose and Sheehan's addition to the City and Town of Ann Arbor is described as follows: All of the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 33, Township 2 South, Range 6 East. Also a part of the Southwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of said Section 33, bounded as follows: Beginning at the S.W. corner of the N.W. quarter of Section 102 3d, T. 2 S., R. 6 E., thence North four chains fifty links, thence East eleven chains eleven links, thence South parallel to the West line four chains fifty links, thence West along the quarter line eleven chains eleven links to the place of beginning, excepting from said N.W. quarter of S.W. quarter the parcel marked "Private Park, Not dedicated".

Know all Men by these presents, That we, Alexander W. Hamilton, Joseph I. Rose, and John V. Sheehan (hereafter as proprietors, and May H. Hamilton and Carrie Rose their wives, have caused the land in the annexed plat to be surveyed, laid out and plotted, to be known as Hamilton, Rose and Sheehan's Addition to the City and Town of Ann Arbor, and that the streets and alleys as shown on said plat are hereby dedicated to the use of the public.
