



### ATTENTION PLEASE

The installation of Traffic Calming devices on Glenwood Road between Override Drive and Washtenaw Avenue is planned to begin **Monday, November 15** and last approximately two weeks. The work will be done utilizing part width construction and sequenced as follows:

- Phase 1 – Construction of all devices on the westerly side of Glenwood Road.
- Phase 2 – Construction of all devices on the easterly side of Glenwood Road with only a portion of the device in the Glenwood/Warwick intersection being constructed in order to maintain vehicular traffic access to/from Warwick Rd. Exmoor Road will be closed to vehicular traffic at Glenwood Road and residents will need to use Edinborough Road and Override Drive.
- Phase 3 – Construction of the remaining portion of the device in the Glenwood/Warwick intersection. Vehicular traffic access to/from Warwick Rd will be maintained on the newly constructed portion of this device.

The contractor's goal is to perform its construction operations with the least amount of inconvenience to property owners. On these days two-way vehicular traffic will be maintained along Glenwood Road except where directly adjacent to the construction where it will operate intermittently in one direction at a time using flag control.

Based on experience, the success of this work depends upon your assistance. Please kindly observe the following:

1. Keep the street free of all trash and recycle receptacles and/or bags, and compost carts.
2.
