Thank you for participating in the first round of Stakeholder Focus Groups.

On November 18, 2013 City Council passed Resolution R-13-367, which established a Pedestrian Safety and Access Task Force to explore strategies to improve pedestrian safety in the City of Ann Arbor. A fourteen month process has been established in which the Task Force will take a comprehensive look at pedestrian safety as it relates to engineering, planning, education, enforcement and operations. The Task Force will recommend to Council improvements in the development and application of the Complete Streets model, using best practices, sound data and objective analysis.

The Task Force plans to engage the entire community in the discussion. As part of this process, there will be three rounds of public engagement where input will be gathered from a combination of stakeholder focus groups, online surveys, crowdsourcing web maps and community-wide meetings.

Today's meeting will focus on identifying pedestrian safety and access issues as they relate to the entire city, targeted areas, and place specific issues. Issues identified during today's meeting will be used to guide input from the general public.
