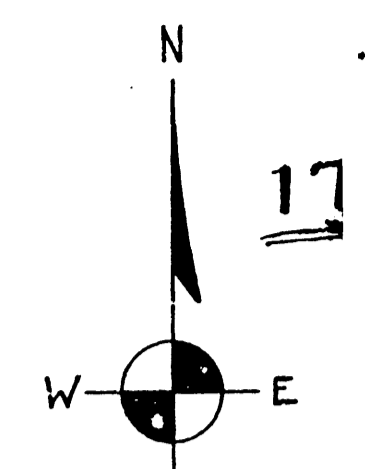
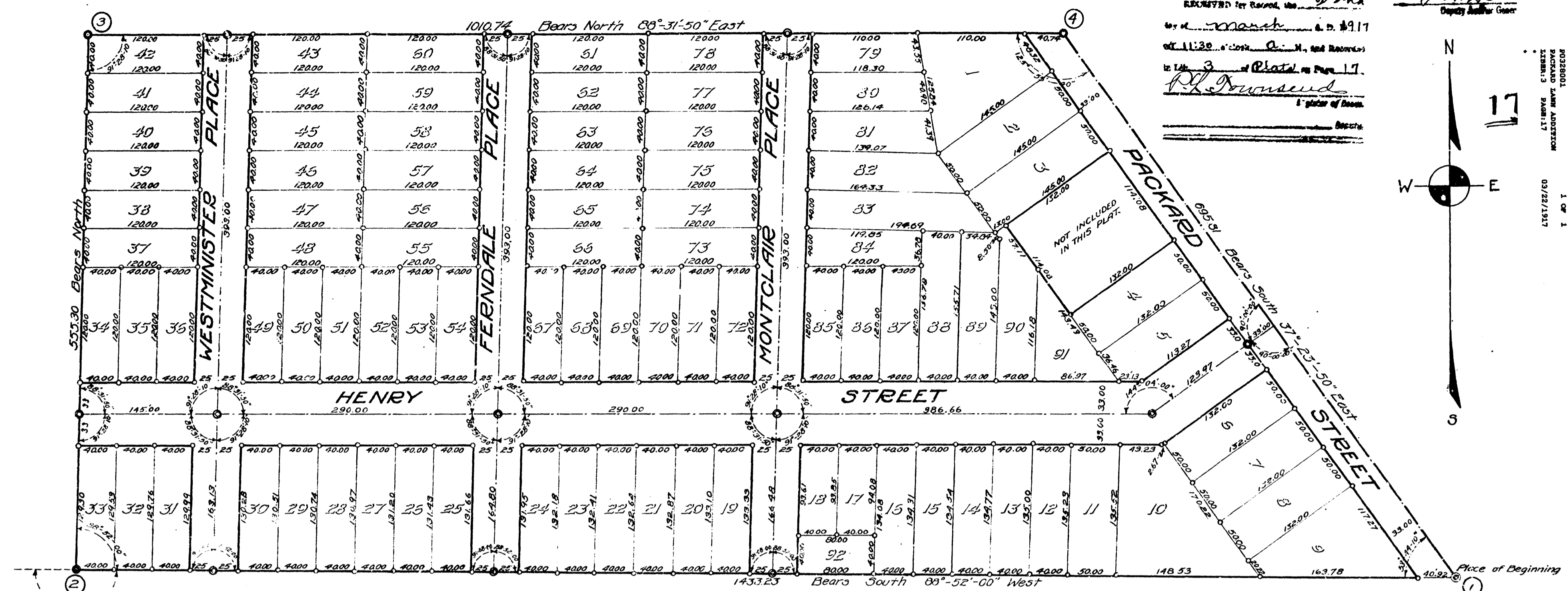

**DESCRIPTION:**  
 The land embraced in the "Packard Lawn Addition" to the City of Ann Arbor is a portion of the south or e half of section 33 Town 2 S, Range 6 E. described as follows: Beginning at the point 1 where the center line of Packard St intersects the east and west center line of the southeast one quarter of section 33, which is the southerly limits of the city of Ann Arbor; thence south 88° 52' 00" west one thousand four hundred thirty three and twenty three one hundredths (1433.23) feet along said east and west center line of the south one half of section 33 to a point 2 which is the center of the southwest one quarter of said section; thence north five hundred fifty five and three tenths (555.30) feet along the north and south center line of the southwest one quarter of section 33 to a point 3; thence north 88° 31' 50" east one thousand ten and seventy four one hundredths (1010.74) feet to a point 4 which is on the center line of Packard St; thence south 37° 23' 50" east six hundred ninety five and eighty-one one hundredths (695.81) feet to the place of beginning. Excepting a parcel of land not to be included in the above plat and described as follows: Commencing on the southwesterly line of Packard St at a point four hundred and thirty three and twenty seven one hundredths (433.27) feet northwesterly along the southwesterly line of Packard St from its intersection with the east and west center line of the southwest one quarter of section 33; running thence southwest at right angles with Packard St one hundred and thirty two (132.00) feet; thence northwesterly parallel with Packard St one hundred and fourteen and eight one hundredths (114.08) feet; thence northeast at right angles one hundred and thirty two (132.00) feet to the southwest side of Packard St; thence southeast along the said southwesterly line of Packard St one hundred and fourteen and eight one hundredths (114.08) feet to the place of beginning.

**SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE:**  
 I hereby certify that the plat hereon delineated is a correct one, and that permanent monuments consisting of iron pipe 1/2" in diameter and 30" long have been planted at all points marked as shown thereon at all angles in the boundaries of the land platted and that permanent monuments consisting of iron pipe 1/2" in diameter and 30" long surrounded with brick have been planted at all points marked at the intersections of all the streets.
