

## ADDENDUM #1

### ITB 4317 - Clinton Park Tennis and Basketball Court Renovations City of Ann Arbor

The following changes, additions, and/or deletions shall be made to the Invitation to Bid for the Clinton Park Tennis and Basketball Court Renovations, for which bids will be received on or before 10:30 A.M. Thursday, January 23, 2014.

The information contained herein shall take precedence over the original documents and is appended thereto. This Addendum includes 4 pages. The changes listed below are identified by page number within the bid document.

**The Contractor is to acknowledge receipt of this Addendum No. 1 on page P-1 of the Bid Documents prior to submitting its Bid.**

1. The use of Reclaimed Asphalt Pavement (RAP) will not be permitted. This is no change from the original bid specification.

2. Fence specifications – addition to plan page 3/3:

12' fence height

Mid and bottom rails are required.

#### Polyester Coating

PVC coating shall be 10 mil minimum, Black color

Warranty shall be for a minimum of 10 years against failure due to rust or corrosion

Shall meet ASTM Specifications F 1043 and F934

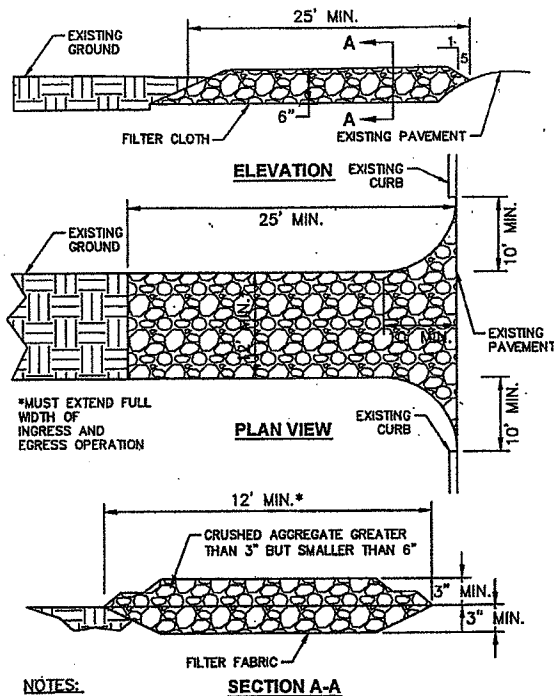
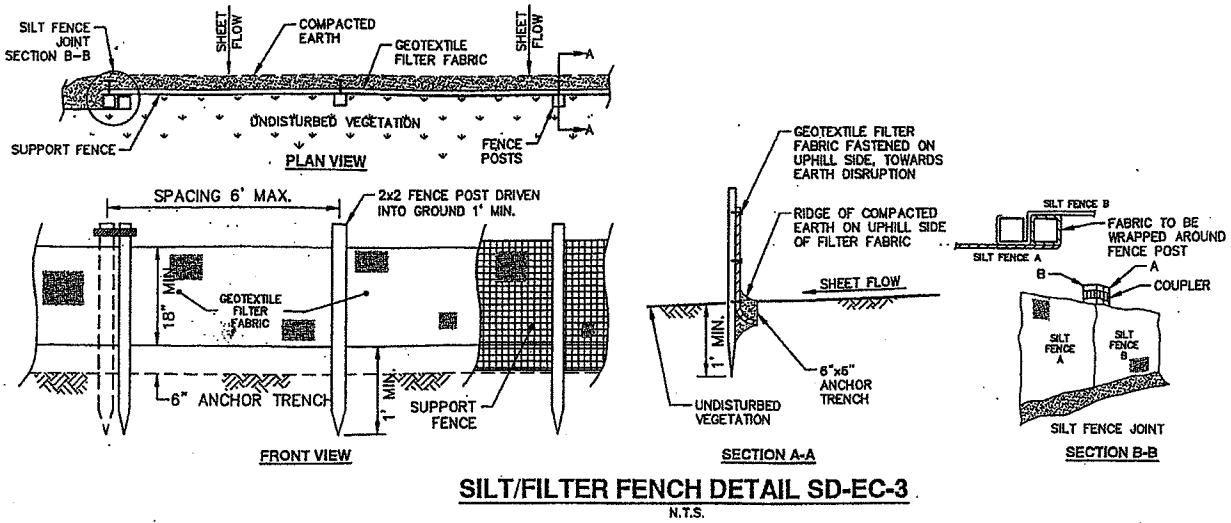

4. Mud tracking – a mud tracking mat shall be added to the entrance where all equipment enters and exits the site. See attached detail.
5. Silt fence is required for this project. See attached detail and quantity on bid form.
6. Testing firm will be hired independently by the City of Ann Arbor.
7. Bids are to be delivered to the first floor Customer Service area of City Hall. The bids will be time stamped by Customer Service staff.
8. Soil boring reports are available upon request.
9. Please use attached replacement bid form and submit with bid. Changes include addition of silt fence, change to quantity of tennis posts, and addition of mud tracking mat within general conditions.

**NOTES:**

1. MUD TRACKING SURFACE MUST BE LONG AND WIDE ENOUGH TO PREVENT VEHICLES ENTERING AND EXITING THE SITE FROM TRACKING SOILS ONTO THE STREET. ANY SOILS TRACKED ONTO THE STREET MUST BE REMOVED IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING EACH TRACKING OCCURRENCE.
2. EXISTING CURB SHALL BE REMOVED AND REPLACE AT THE LOCATION OF THE MUD TRACKING SURFACE AREA.
