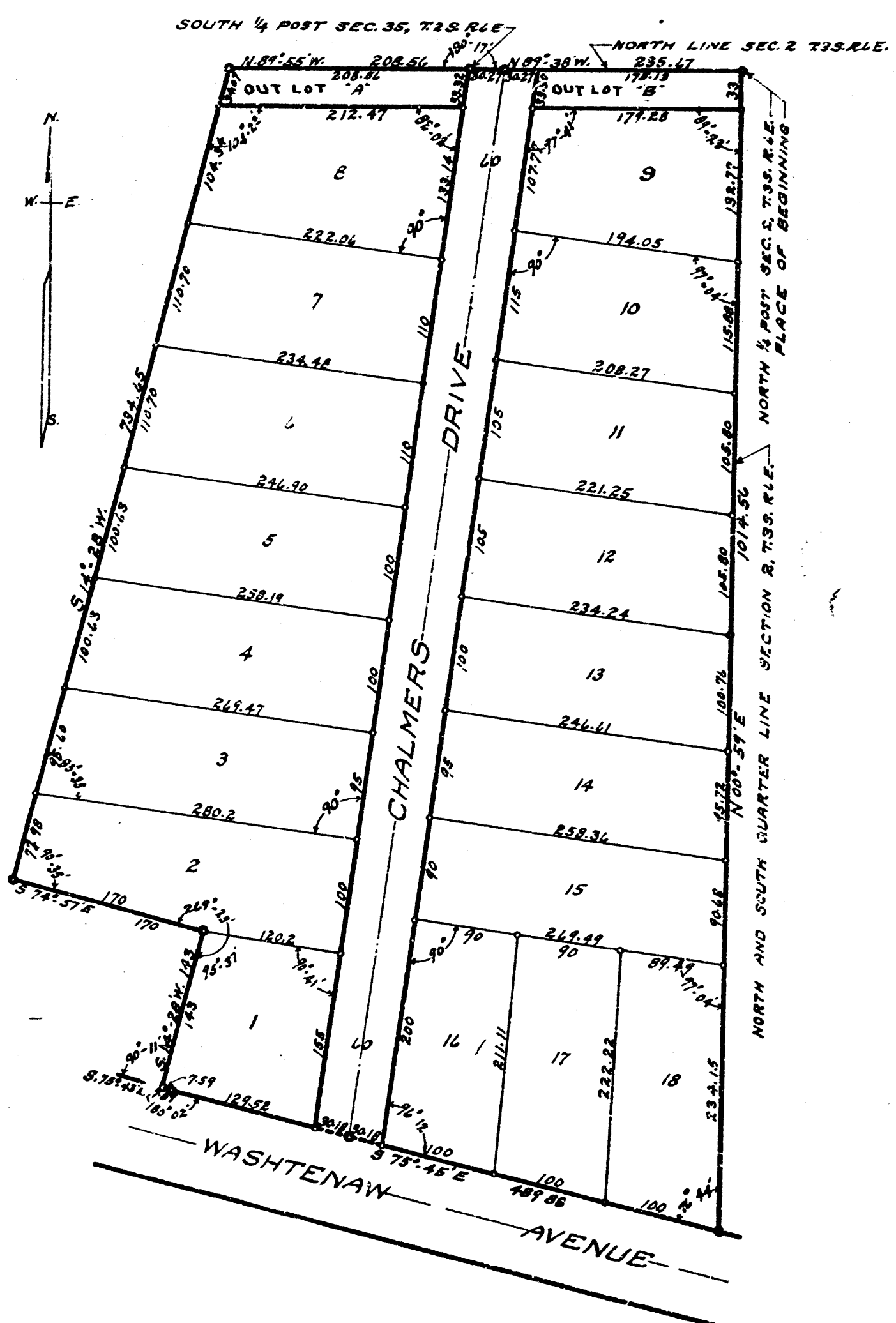

 Commencing at the north quarter post, section two, Town three south, range six east, Washtenaw County, Michigan; thence N. 89° - 38' W. along the north line of said section two 235.67 feet to the south quarter post, section two, Town two south, range six east; thence N. 89° - 55' W. along the south line of said section two, 208.56 feet; thence S. 14° - 28' W. 724.65 feet; thence S. 74° - 57' E. 170 feet; thence S. 14° - 28' W. 148.75 feet to the north line of Washtenaw Avenue; thence S. 75° - 43' E. along said north line 7.88 feet; thence south along said north line 208.56 feet to the intersection of the north line of said section two with the north and south quarter lines of section two, Town three south, range six east; thence N. 60° - 30' E. along the north line of said quarter line 1024.56 feet to the place of
