 It is on the north part of land deeded to
 Eliza Black and recorded on page 804
 Lib 51 of deeds. It is bounded as follows
 Commencing at a fence post which is 20
 chains and 47 links South of the North line
 of Sec 21 T. 2. R. 6 E. and thence chains and 89 links
 West of the North and South gr. line of the Section, thence
 West parallel to the North side of the Section and
 along a fence which is recognized as the N 1/2 gr
 line 180 chains 16 links to a stake and stones in the
 center of the highway, thence North 15 degrees West 17 chains
 75 links along the center of the highway thence East
 perpendicular to the highway 4 chains, thence South 15
 degrees West 46 links, thence South 51 1/4 degrees East 2 chains
 95 links to a fence post, thence North 58 1/4 degrees East 15
 chains, thence North 39 1/4 degrees East 11 chains and 68 links
