NOTICE: Final Plan Revision for Traffic Calming on Manchester Rd (Buckingham to Needham)

Dear Manchester Road Resident/Owner,

Thank you for your participation and involvement in the Manchester Traffic Calming Project. The final plan was approved in September 2023 and your patience with the installation of devices has been greatly appreciated.

Due to the technical challenges installing raised crosswalks, the final plan for traffic calming on **Manchester Rd from Buckingham to Needham** has been slightly revised, reference revised plan included. The following one (1) device has been modified:

Device 2 - Raised Crosswalk at Nottingham Rd will become a speed hump which will be located just north of the crosswalk.

Why did the revision(s) occur?

It's the city's responsibility to make sure all crosswalks are compliant with Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). Due to the geometry of Manchester Rd it is unachievable to install the raised crosswalk in a manner that would reduce speed and be American with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant.

Who was part of this decision?

Transportation Engineers, the Transportation Manager, and experts in construction inspection have been working hard to try and determine a feasible plan to install the device as originally approved. However, the decision to make these changes was made after a field visit was conducted and it was determined modifications were warranted to achieve speed management as well as ADA accessibility.

When will devices be installed?

Preparations for construction will start the week of April 1 and last approximately four (4) weeks, weather dependent. Devices will be installed in phases to minimize the impacts to residents.

What are the temporary impacts to residents during construction?

- 1) On-street parking will be temporarily restricted at identified locations within the project area.
- 2) Closures to one lane on Manchester, within the project area, will occur. Please adhere to all parking restrictions and signage during construction to ensure the project can be completed in a safe and timely manner.
