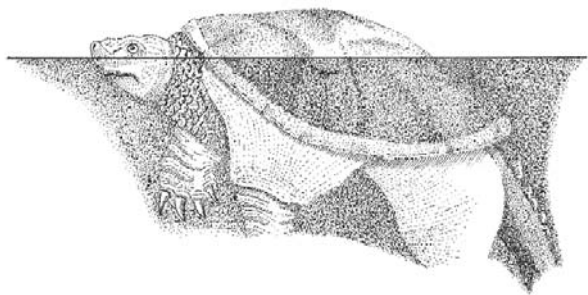


Along the HURON

The Natural Communities of the Huron River Corridor in Ann Arbor, Michigan

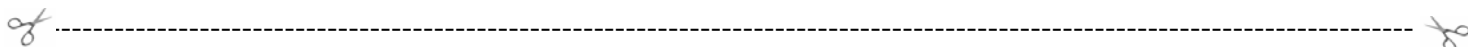
