BENCHMARKING FINDINGS



POLICY & MANAGEMENT

- Bandshells are being built & renovated all over the country in small towns & large cities
- Venues are rented and managed by both cities and community foundations
- Amplification is allowed at all benchmarked facilities
- Improvements were paired with a plan to actively program events. Some venues are programmed by a community partner and others were by the city, including one that hired an event coordinator
- Most venues host an annual concert series with 12+ events run by the city or a community partner, plus additional rentals by other organizations, artists, and community members
- Most venues host a variety of types of events, including non-performance uses such as weddings and social gatherings

INFRASTRUCTURE & IMPROVEMENTS

- Typical audience capacity ranges from 1,200-1,800
- Amount of backstage space varies and has a significant impact on cost
- Lower cost projects (<\$3M) installed a simple, open-air structure, built no or a small amount (600 sf) of backstage space, and had minimal audience improvements
- Nearly all venues included bathrooms or were proximate to existing bathrooms
- Most audience areas were gently sloping plazas and lawns, some venues provided rows of permanent seating
- Only one venue relocated the historic structure, which was a highly valued bandshell with significance to people across the state of Michigan
