


# E.H.WAPLES' FIRST ADDN.

TO THE CITY OF ANN ARBOR,  
WASHTENAW COUNTY, MICH.



Description—The land embraced in the annexed plat of E.H.Waples' First Add'n to the city of Ann Arbor, Washtenaw Co. Mich is described as follows: Beginning at the S.W. corner of Tappan Park on the N.E. side of Grove St. thence SEly along said side of Grove St. 132.00; thence deflecting to the left  $90^{\circ}54'30''$  a distance 248.26; thence deflecting to the right  $36^{\circ}44'15''$  a distance 480.00; thence deflecting to the left  $91^{\circ}47'00''$  a distance 146.4 [this being the W. side of E. University Ave.], thence deflecting to the left  $88^{\circ}13'00''$  a distance 5091; thence deflecting  $36^{\circ}44'15''$  to the left a distance 313.64' to the place of beginning, being a part of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 33. T. 2 S. R. 6 E. Meridian Mich.
